

In connection with the finalization of Curriculum under the Semester system, many workshops were conducted involving most members of Faculty of Islamic Theology in the Dept. of Islamic Theology, Aliah University Main Campus. The Controller of Examinations and Asst. Controller of Examinations were also present in three meetings on 21.10.14, 12.11.14 and 13. 11. 2014. The following programmes which will be covered under Semester System from session 2014-15 are

Controller of Examinations

- 1. 3-yr B.A. (Hons.) in Theology [Kamil (Hons.)]
- 2. 3-yr B.A. in Theology [Kamil (Gen.)]
- 3. 2-yr M.A. in Theology [M.M.]

After thorough discussions, the Curricula have been finalized following the existing norms of the Semester system which is being followed in other departments of the University. The contents of each Course (Paper) are maintained as it was there in the Annual system. However, little modification and/or adjustment has been made so that the volume of the Course content remains more or less the same in all Semesters of the Programme.

After that, the Head (officiating) called a meeting on 24.11.2014 which was attended by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Registrar, Controller of Examinations, Dy.Registrar, Asstt. Controller of Examinations, all permanent faculties, G.S. of Students Union and most class representatives. It was discussed, finalized and resolved by all members unanimously to conduct the courses of the Dept. of Islamic Theology on and from the current session 2014-15 under the Semester system of studies.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor took the chair and delivered the introductory speech. His speech broadly covered on the necessity of Semester system for improved learning. Main points of the speech of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor were:

- Up-to-date and need-based Curriculum

The curriculum should focus on its target. After completion of a particular programme of study in the University level, a large share of the students look for job, and the rest go for higher study/ research. So, the curriculum should be prepared in such a way that it would help students to increase their employability as well as it will provide a good platform for higher study and research.

For example, Bengali may be offered as one of the Elective in Kamil Hons. The choice of Electives may further be extended to other subjects like Geography, English also. On the other hand the syllabus of Arabic need to be prepared in such a way that students must learn to read and write Arabic in properly.

- Continuity of Curriculum
The curriculum of undergraduate level i.e., Kamil of Aliah University should have continuity from 'Fazil' Programme, which will again have the continuity from 'Alim' Programme.
 - Uplifting Madrasah Students
Students coming for studying Theology in Aliah University are from Madrasah back ground. Such Madrasahs neither able to provide in-depth education of the religious field nor they are able to provide Modern education. Time has come to uplift those large no. of students who are deprived of modern education in Madrasahs.

The Vice-Chancellor then requested to continue the meeting as per agenda.

Agenda-1: Introduction of Semester system for Programmes offered by Dept. of Theology

The main agenda of the meeting was regarding implementation of Semester system for Programmes offered by Dept. of Theology. The issue of introducing Semester system was under discussion for long time. The feasibility of introducing Semester system was checked from all points of view, e.g., Curriculum, Faculty, similar programme under Madrasahs etc. The faculties and students were all agreed upon that the Semester system is to be followed as soon as possible.

In view of the same, the Semester system has been introduced for Kamil (Hons.), Kamil (Gen), and M.M. Programmes of the Main Campus (21, Haji Md. Mohsin Sq.) of Aliah University from session 2014-15. It has been approved by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor

Renaming of Kamil and M.M.:

Following the UGC guideline, the above mentioned Programmes have been renamed as:

- i. 3-yr B.A. (Hons.) in Theology [Kamil (Hons.)]
- ii. 3-yr B.A. in Theology [Kamil (Gen.)]
- iii. 2-yr M.A. in Theology [M.M.]

'Kamil' and 'M.M.' will be replaced by 'Fazil', and 'Kamil' respectively afterwards. Members decided to mention 'Theology' only, instead of 'Islamic Theology', as it would be more reasonable considering the fact that 'Comparative Study of the Religions' Course is offered in the Programme. The proposal of renaming of above programmes was approved by the Vice-Chancellor.

Curriculum:

HOD (Off.) of Dept. of Islamic Theology presented the Curriculum 3-yr B.A. (Hons.) in Theology [Kamil (Hons.)], 3-yr B.A. in Theology [Kamil (Gen.)], 2-yr M.A. in Theology [M.M.] which have been prepared involving all faculties. He further informed that Controller of Examinations, and Asst. Controller of Examinations were also present in three occasions so that the Curriculum was prepared at par with the existing Examinations procedures under Semester system.

Registrar remarked that the Curriculum should be prepared as per UGC norm. He further expressed that the Syllabus of History should be more focused on Islamic History rather than the Modern History of India.

The Controller of Examinations expressed that the Curriculum need to be upgraded at par with the other Programmes offered by other Departments in Semester system. For example, the contents of Communicative English, Environmental studies etc. should be revised and replaced by the syllabus as followed in all departments of the University.

Hon'ble VC expressed that the Curriculum of above three Programmes need to be prepared by an Expert Committee. **However, for the current session, the Vice-Chancellor approved the Curriculum to continue as classes have already been commenced following this Curriculum.**

Need of faculties:

It was expressed by all that sufficient faculties are required to run the academic affairs smoothly. The part time faculties who are engaged may be better remunerated.

The Vice-Chancellor expressed that as per Govt. norm three part-time faculties may be engaged against each vacant post (faculty). In this connection, The Vice-Chancellor requested Dy. Registrar to formulate, in line of other State Universities, a package which may be offered to such part-time faculties.

2+1 System in other Madrasahs:

The Vice-Chancellor informed that all three Madrasahs at Beldanga, Batna, and Furfura will be visited by a Committee comprising Secretary of Dept. of MA & ME, himself, Registrar, and Controller of Examinations to find the feasibility to introduce Semester system. Till then, **Madrasahs will continue existing 2+1 System of Kamil (Hons. & Gen) Programme, and 1+1 System M.M. Programme.**

In this regard, the Controller of Examinations opined that Madrasahs might not be allowed to introduce B. A. programme (under Semester System) as they are not of College status.

The Vice-Chancellor expressed that Govt may be requested to upgrade Madrasahs to College, then there won't be any problem for offering B.A. programme. Certain Madrasahs are willing to offer land/ separate building so that those can be upgraded to College, whereas others are not willing. This matter will also be looked in to.

Agenda 2: Schedule of Examinations:

The Mid-Semester Examinations of 3-yr B.A. (Hons.) in Theology [Kamil (Hons.)], 3-yr B.A. in Theology [Kamil (Gen.)], and 2-yr M.A. in Theology [M.M.] will be held in **December 15-24, 2014** along with the End-Semester Examinations of Dept. of Arabic, and Dept. of Education.

The End-Semester Examinations will be held from January 27, 2015 onwards.

The Vice-Chancellor approved it.

Agenda 3: Venue:

The venue of Mid-Semester Examinations will be the **B. Ed. Building, Main Campus, 21 Haji Md. Mohsin Sq.** However, some of the rooms/ Library of the Heritage (Old) building may also be used, if all students cannot be accommodated in the B. Ed. Building.

After completion of the agenda-wise discussion, in order to improve Examination system, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor advised that

- Home-center examinations will not be allowed for Madrasahs
- Model questions and model solutions should be provided by the concerned Examiner
- Answer scripts should be coded
- Centralized spot evaluation system should be started for publishing results in time
- Honorarium for evaluation of Answer script should be at par with other Universities, etc.

The Vice-Chancellor also asked students present in the meeting to mention few areas for further improvement. Points which were raised by students are:

1. Furniture in the Class rooms
2. Computer facility including Internet for students
3. More faculties
4. Reservation (Minority status) of Muslim students in Aliah University

The Vice-Chancellor expressed that quality furniture, provision of Computer facility etc. are being created. Process of engaging faculties will also start. So far the last point is concerned, the majority of Muslim students of our State is not inclined to study at Aliah University. He compared the data of no. of Muslim students appeared in WBJEE to no. of students appeared in AUAT. It shows that the no. of students applied to Aliah University are much less than the no. of Muslim students appeared in JEE. The Vice-Chancellor remarked that rather the concentration should be more on to attract Muslim students to Aliah University which is now offering education in many modern and conventional branches of study.
