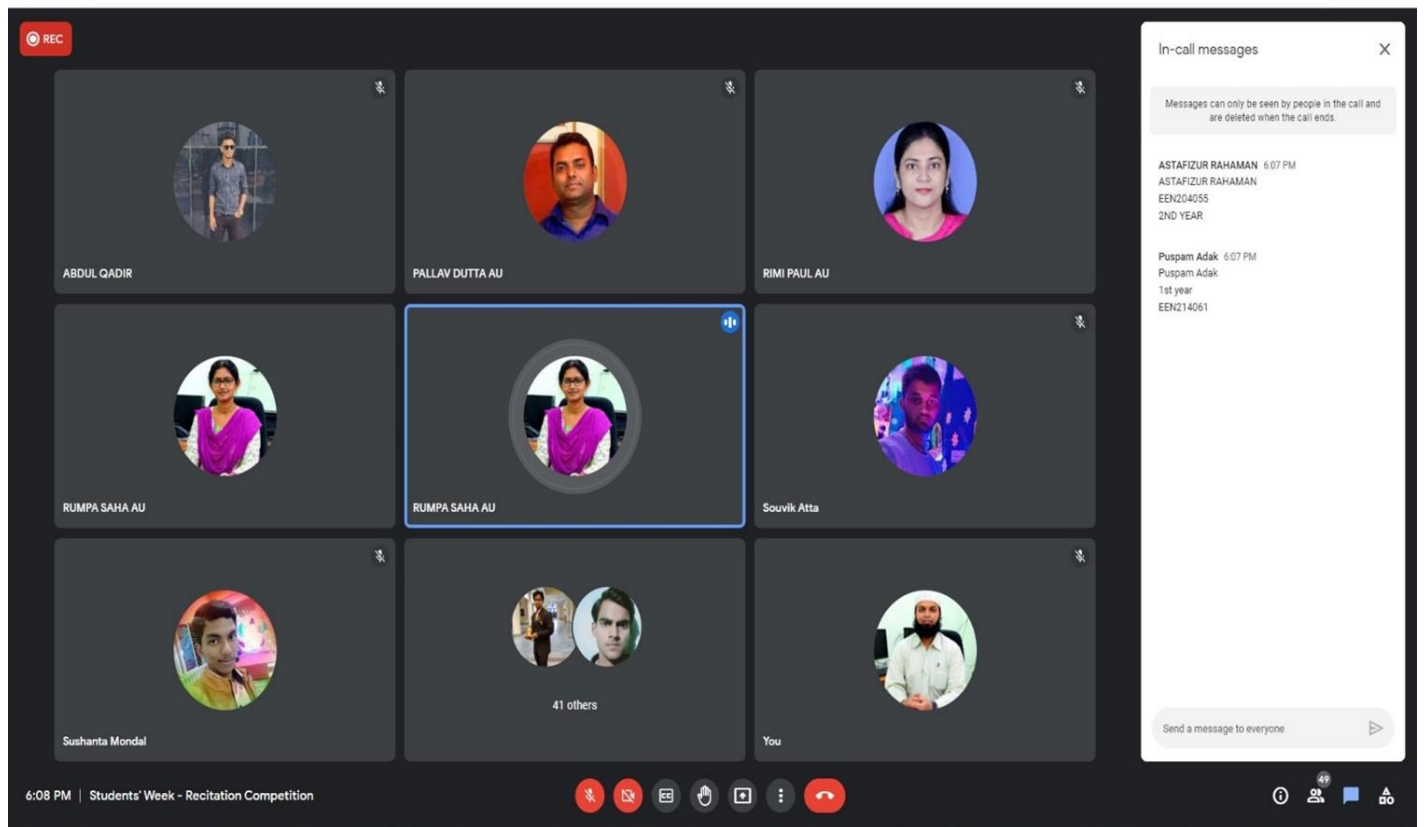


Celebration of Students' Week Guardians Meet
