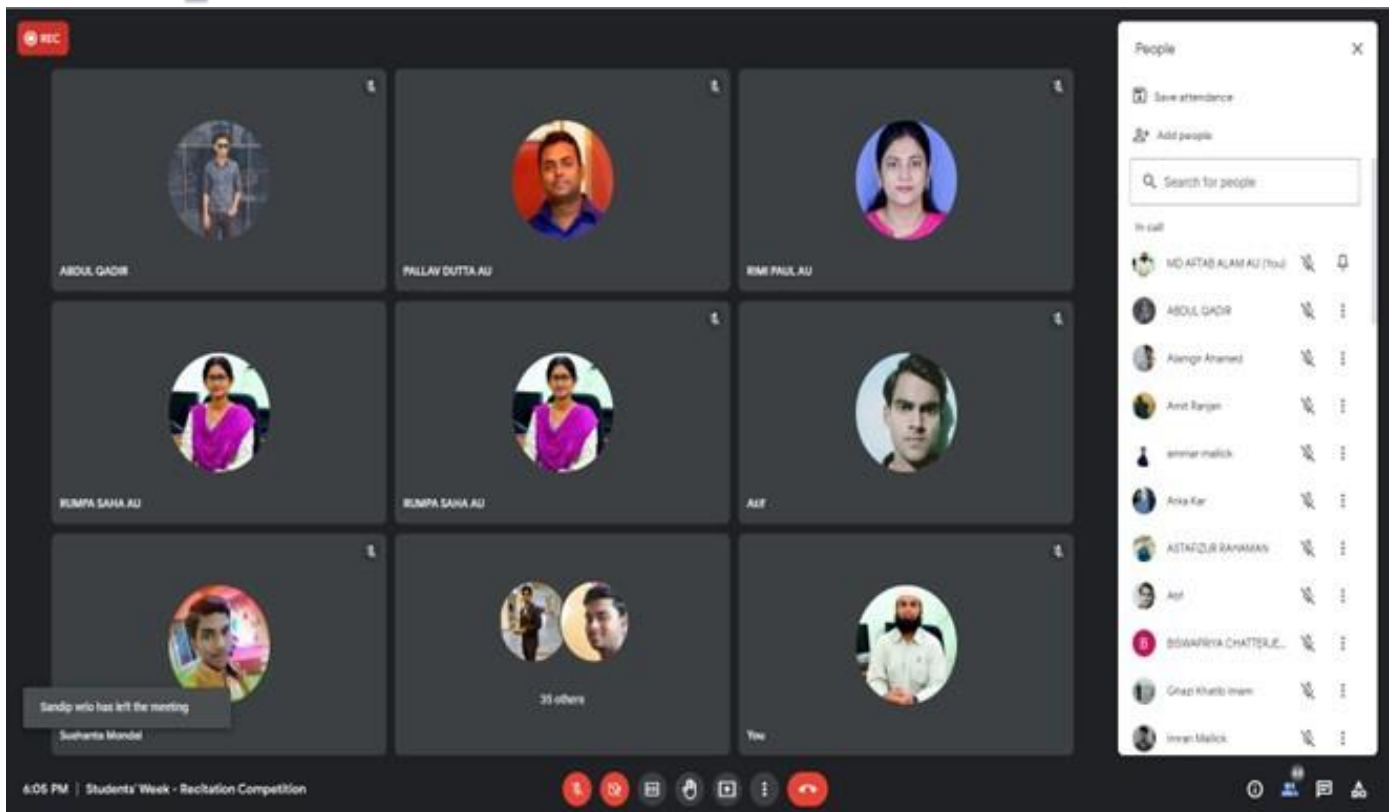


# Celebration of Students' Week
