INTRODUCTION

National Cadet Corps is a Tri-Services Organization, comprising the Army, Navy and Air Force, engaged in grooming the youth of the country into disciplined and patriotic citizens. The National Cadet Corps (NCC) is a youth development movement. It has enormous potential for nation building. The NCC Provides opportunities to the youth of the country for their all-round development with a sense of Duty, Commitment, Dedication, Discipline and Moral Values so that they become able leaders and useful citizens. The NCC provides exposure to the cadets in a wide range of activities, with a distinct emphasis on Social Services, Discipline and Adventure Training. The NCC is open to all regular students of schools and colleges on a voluntary basis all over India. The cadets have no liability for active military service once they complete their course but are given preference over normal candidates during selections based on the achievements in the corps.

Aliah University Senior Division NCC Unit was formed by the DGNCC under 31 Bengal Bn NCC, Kol-B, Coy-2, NCC House, Fort William, Kolkata-700021 on 8th September 2021 (no. 0102/02/IV/A-III Dated 08.10.2021). NCC class is held every Friday from 8.00 am to 10 am.

Vision

The vision of Aliah University NCC is to develop well-rounded individuals imbued with a strong sense of national pride, equipped with leadership qualities, and committed to serving the country with integrity and honor.

Swachhta Diwas
