Aliah University is a State University, which came into existence through West Bengal Act XXVII of 2007, also known as The Aliah University Act, 2007 passed by the West Bengal Legislative Assembly. The Act came into force on 5 April 2008. Aliah University was upgraded from the Calcutta Madrasah College (erstwhile Madrasah Aliah). The Aliah University has approvals from statutory bodies like UGC, AICTE, NCTE, INC and WBNC.

The University has 3 Campuses and offers 23 academic departments which offer 49 academic programmes. The present intake capacity is 1090 students at the postgraduate level and 1480 students at the undergraduate level. The University has already introduced the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) to the undergraduate and postgraduate programmes. Research programmes in various disciplines are also being pursued actively and there is immense scope for progress in the near future. Apart from offering various academic programmes in Science, Engineering, Language, Social Sciences, Law, Nursing, B.Ed, we also offer Value Added Courses (VACs) to enhance the employability of our students.

Apart from the regular process of teaching, learning and research, Aliah University, aims to instill the dynamism of its glorious heritage of the past among all its students and scholars, so that they can successfully cope with the critical needs and challenges of the present and contribute to the future advancement of science, technology, and human civilization.

In 2021an Institute's Innovation Council (IIC), as well as Innovation Centre, was setup to promote innovation, entrepreneurship, start-up and incubation at Aliah University. The primary aim is to boost local home-bred entrepreneurial and start-up ventures which will help students, faculties and other members of the ambient population. We at Aliah University, are trying to get projects funded by the Central as well as the State Government that may help to strengthen its drive in the domain of social entrepreneurship. The University has established strong academic linkages with various national and international institutions like the University of Ulster (otherwise known as Ulster University) ("Ulster"), United Kingdom, Edunet Foundation, Ardent Computech Pvt. Ltd., etc. Academicians from a large number of universities and institutions of national and international repute visit and participate in various academic programmes at Aliah University.

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During the pandemic situation, different departments of the Aliah University organized a large number of webinars with distinguished experts, professionals and in-house faculty members as panellists on the thrust areas. These webinars were targeted at faculty development programmes (FDPs), innovation & research.

We at Aliah are very much committed to society at large. During the pandemic situation followed by natural disasters like Amphan and Yaas, the University has actively participated in relief activities.

The Training and Placement Cell has introduced the "Communicative English and Student Development Programme" for B. Tech., MBA, and MCA students. A programme on "Elementary English for Adult Learners" was also introduced for Theology and Arabic students. As a step towards academic and industrial partnership, Aliah University has signed MOUs with many renowned organizations e.g. National Small Industries Corporation Ltd. (NSIC), KRACKiN Skill X, Edunet Foundation, - Ardent Computech Private Limited etc. To enhance employability, and core competencies among students, experts from industry and professional organizations are invited for grooming, up-skilling, and soft skill-development of students from 3rd year and final year batches.

Aliah University is a network institute of the Indian Institute of Remote Sensing (IIRS) under the Indian Space Research Organisation, Department of Space, Govt. of India, outreach network. The name of our University is included in the online application form for IIRS Outreach Programme and conducting live & amp; Interactive courses at our Institute/ Organization. Currently, our University is listed as one of the nodal centres to conduct online courses offered by IIRS-ISRO Dehradun. The total number of On-Campus, Pool Campus, and Off-Campus drives held between 2018 -2022 (April) is 265.

We, at the Aliah University, endeavour to inculcate competency, creativity, and compassion in every student to work for the advancement of the educationally backward classes and marginalized sections of society. The University believes in cultural pluralism and unity in diversity for which our country is always recognized everywhere with deep respect.



programme will be conducted. Admission for all PG

programmes will be taken through solely on merit score

of AUAT-2022 examination whereas admission for

B.Ed programme will be taken through merit score of

AUAT-2022 examination and academic results.



6. Historical Background:

Aliah University has a unique pre-history. A brief look at this will offer an understanding of its social and cultural importance. Its parent institution Aliah Madrasah was the first government-funded educational institution in British India. The chief intention for establishing this institution was to educate the children of Muslim families in Arabic, Persian and Muslim Law so that they might be eligible to get jobs in different Government Departments like revenue administration and the judiciary. However, within a decade the curriculum of Aliah Madrasah had also encompassed modern subjects like arithmetic, geometry, astronomy and the natural sciences along with the more traditional branches of learning like Law, Theology, Elementary Grammar, Philosophy and Logic. In 1821, the Annual Examination of the Madrasah was held in the presence of many respectable officials and gentlemen of Calcutta. This was the first public examination held in British India. A medical class, headed by Dr Peter Breton, Professor of Medicine, was started at this Madrasah in 1826 for the first time in British India. Dr Breton was authorized to purchase a skeleton and collect medical books. An anatomical work published by John Taylor was arranged to be translated into Arabic. The medical class continued here till the establishment of Calcutta Medical College in 1836. However, the students of the Madrasah were allowed to study medicine at Calcutta Medical College. This speaks for the high standard of education at the Madrash in those days. English was first introduced at Aliah Madrasah in 1826, though the number of students was quite low as Persian was still medium of administration in British India. In 1854 at the recommendation of a Committee an English school, in the name of Anglo-Persian Department, was started under the direct control of the Principal of Calcutta Madrasah. After the Revolt of 1857, the British rulers began to have a suspicious attitude to the Muslims. There were proposals to abolish the Madrasah. However, in 1860, the Government of India, rejecting the idea of abolition, rather recommended improvement in its management. So the Madrasah continued to exist. Some reforms were introduced at the Calcutta Madrasah according to the suggestions of a committee consisting of C.H. Campbell, Commissioner of the Presidency Division, I. Sutcliff, Principal of Presidency College, and Nawab Abdul Latif, then a Deputy Magistrate. Further reforms were introduced at the recommendations of the Education Commission headed by-W.W. Hunter in 1884. Nawab Abdul Latif and Justice Syed Amir Ali played a very important role in these reforms. In 1896 Elliot Hostel was founded, with funds raised out of donations from the public. In 1902 the Muslim Institute was established as a part and parcel of Calcutta Madrasah. The Principal of the Madrasah was ex-officio President and Treasurer of the Muslim Institute. Several committees and commissions were appointed in 1915, 1923, 1931, 1938-40, and 1946 for the improvement in the syllabi, curricula and all round development of Madrasah education in Bengal, particularly of Calcutta Madrasah. After Partition in 1947, this institution again faced severe problems. According to the decision of the Separation Council, all books and manuscripts, assets and estates of the Aliah Madrasah were transferred to the Dhaka Madrasah. It was only at the initiative of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, the first Education Minister of independent India, that the institutional framework of Calcutta Madrasah was again set up and teaching restarted. In 2001, the Government of West Bengal, under the direction of the eminent educationist and the then Governor of West Bengal and Bihar, Dr. A. R. Kidwai, formed a Madrasah Education Committee. This Committee presented its recommendations for the continued development and future excellence of Aliah Madrasah in 2002. Finally, the over-two-hundredyear old institution was elevated to the status of a University in 2007. Aliah University – a State University under the Department of Minority Affairs and Madrasah Education, Government of West Bengal – came into existence through the Aliah University Act (Act XXVII of 2007) passed by the West Bengal Legislative Assembly. The Act came into force on 5 April 2008. Classes were being held in various rented buildings at Sector I and Sector V of Salt Lake City, apart from the Heritage building at Haji Md Mohsin Square. In 2011 the Government of West Bengal led by Mamata Banerjee, the Hon'ble Chief Minister, allotted 20 acres of land at New Town and the foundation stone for the New Town Campus was laid by her on 15 December 2011. The newly-built building was inaugurated by her on 11 November 2014, National Education Day. By this time the G+9 building at Park Circus Campus was also completed. So, the academic and administrative activities of the university started at both these two new campuses from January 2015. It may be observed that Aliah Madrasah from its early days imparted teaching in both the traditional subject of theology and the modern sciences, social sciences, and humanities. To keep alive this tradition of teaching, right from the start, Aliah University has offered courses in the traditional Islamic Theology and Arabic along with subjects like English, Bengali, History and Geography and many other branches of Science (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Statistics, Biological Sciences) as well as Engineering (Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics and Communications, Computer Science and Engineering), Management and Business Adminstration, Nursing and Journalism and Mass Communication. Keeping in mind the requirements of the employment sector in the 21st century, right from the start, great emphasis has been put on courses in the Sciences, Engineering, Technology and Management, so that students from the minority community become eligible and can compete for jobs in various sectors. In keeping with the great stress laid by the UGC on the Semester system of education and Letter Grade process of marking, Aliah University has adopted semesterization, credit system, continuous assessment, and letter grading from its inception. All UG carriculum is running under CBCS pattern as per UGC from 2019-20 and 2020-21 academic sessions and steps were already being taken to introduce the CBCS in all PG programmes from 2021-22 academic session.

7. SPIRIT OF ALIAH UNIVERSITY:

The spirit of Aliah University engraved in its motto, 'Advancement of Education and Culture' in Arabic "Taqdeem-ut-Ta'leemwa-as Saqafah" which is very significant and suggestive and breaks all the barriers which comes to acquire modern and scientific education. It urges its students for unabating quest for acquiring higher education along with creating sensible human being with imbedded cultural and ethical values.

8. VISION

Aliah University is marching on with a vision to recapture the ambience and dynamic cultural heritage of the Calcutta Madrasah College, to expand and deepen it, to evolve it further with a successful outreach into the emerging areas in each branch of modern science, technology, social studies, and humanities. It aims to instill the dynamism of its glorious heritage of the past among all its students, so that they can successfully cope with the critical needs and challenges of the present and contribute to the future advancement of science, technology, and human civilization. It also hopes to develop in its students the love and respect for the fellow citizens of the country and to cherish the ideals of secularism and national integrity.

- 3 year B.A. Hons. in Islamic Theology and Islamic Studies comprised as per syllabi of Fazil according to West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education (WBBME).
- 3 year B.Sc.(Hons.) in Statistics as per syllabus of classes XI & XII of Mathematics of H.S of WBCHSE
- 2 year Masters programmes excluding MJMC will be on concerned subject.
- MJMC will be on English concept of language and Literature, Fundamentals of Journalism and Mass Communication having its role as forth pillar of Indian Democracy, Sports and Cinema.
- 2 year MCA programme will comprise of Reasoning, Quantitative Aptitude, Data Interpretation, Problem Solving Questions, Discrete Quantitative Analysis and basic Mathematics.
- For LL.M. Programme According to the LLB programme of recognised University.
- For B.Ed programme syllabus will comprise of Reasoning, Teaching attitude and General knowledge and current affairs.

Syllabus for General English, General Knowledge, Islamic History & Culture :

- General English: Basic knowledge of vocabularies, grammar and comprehension at 10+2 level.
- General knowledge: This will comprise of History (Medieval and Modern India), Geography, Political Science, General Science and Current Affairs.
- Islamic History & Culture: will be based on 10+2 level.

27. ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

Admission Procedure in details:

Selection and admission procedure of the candidates in Aliah University is based on the following steps.

ONLINE APPLICATION

- All Candidates wish to take admission in Aliah University must apply through online mode of application only. Link and details instruction will be given in the Aliah University website (www.aliah.ac.in) on scheduled date.
- Candidates are advised to follow thoroughly the application guidelines before applying online.
- After submitting the online application successfully a confirmation sheet/application submission form bearing the full application summary with the photo & signature of the candidate will be generated by the system. Application is not complete until the confirmation sheet/application submission form is generated.
- Candidates have to download and print the confirmation sheet/application submission form and should preserve the same carefully.
- Photograph and signature must be maintained in proper pixel and aspect ratio.
- Candidates are advised to ensure the correctness of your complete mailing address, pin code, e-mail address and mobile number. Please note that the University will not be responsible if candidates could not be reached due to incomplete or illegible address, email, or mobile number.
- Select the centers in order of your preference.
- Final decision regarding allotment of the Test/Entrance/Examination Centre for AUAT-2022 will be taken by the authority.
- Request for change of Test/Entrance/Examination Centre in any stage will not be entertained.

MARKS/ MARKSHEET UPLOAD

Candidates have to upload the required Marks/ Marksheet/ Dcuments during online application but the candidates who are apprering in the qualifying examination they have to upload required Marks/ Marksheet/ Dcuments as per the notification/application guidelines given in the Aliah University website (www.aliah.ac.in).

ADMIT CARD

- Candidates have to download and print the admit card within the stipulated time log
 in into admission portal by useing his/her User Id and Password.
- Exam/Test venue and schedule will be mentioned in the admit card.
- No hardcopy admit card will be sent to the respective candidates.
- The admit card will bear the name, photograph, signature, address and category of the candidate along with name and address of the examination center.
- The candidate should carefully examine the admit card. In case of any discrepancy, the candidate should inform the AUAT office immediately.

ALIAH UNIVERSITY ADMISSION TEST (AUAT-2022)

- Candidates have to appear for the Aliah University Admission Test (AUAT-2022) as per the Date, Time & Venue mentioned in the admit card.
- Apprearing in the examination does not gurantee for admission.
- For tentative schedule please see the table (Page No.-08).

PROVISIONAL MERIT LIST

- Provisional Merit List/ Result will be published and candidates have to download and print the Rank Card log in into admission portal by useing his/her User Id and Password.
- A list of Successful candidates of different programmes will be displayed separately on the Aliah University website (www.aliah.ac.in).
- Merit list will be prepared solely based on admission test score (except 2-year B.Ed programme).
- Separate list of successful candidates will also be prepared for the physically challenged (PC) candidates.

COUNSELLING

Candidate having valid rank are only eligible for counselling.

Offline Counselling: Offline Counselling will be held only for the programme codes: U21, U13 & U14.

- A general merit list will be published for U21-B.Tech programmes and next to get allotment, candidates have to be present for offline counselling on the schedule date, time and venue to select the specific programme(subject)
- A general merit list will be published for Mathematics and Statistics programmes and next to get allotment, candidates have to be present for offline counselling on the schedule date, time and venue to select the programme.
- A general merit list will be published for 3 year B.Sc. Honours in Botany/ Microbiology/ Zoology programmes and next to get allotment, candidates have to be present for offline counselling on the schedule date, time and venue to select the programme.

E-Counselling: E-Counselling will be held only for the programme codes: U08 & P08.

- A general merit list will be published for U08-3 year B.A. Honours in Islamic Theology and P08-2 year M.A. in Islamic Theology and the next e-counselling will be done to select the study centre.
- If candidates are not allotted in his/her 1st choice, we will consider his/her 2nd choice (if given by him/her) and this process will continue until his/her last choice.
- The choice submitted by the candidates during application/ counselling will be processed and a seat will be allotted based on merit/rank, if available.
 - Taking part in Counselling process does not guarantee the admission.
- In case candidates fail to present/ attened at the Counselling process then, his/her candidature will be cancelled.
- Any decision taken by the conducting authority in regard to any issue related to counselling will be deemed as final.
- The list of eligible candidates to attend the offline counselling/ e-counselling, schedule, procedure, venue and other relevant details will be made available on Aliah University website (www.aliah.ac.in).

PROVISIONAL ALLOTMENT LIST

- Provisional Allotment list will be published at the schedule date and in this regards also candidates have to follow regularly the Aliah University website (www.aliah.ac.in).
- Candidates who will be enlisted in the provisional allotment list only can pay the admission fees online.

- The allotment offered at the counselling is only a provisional allotment.
- All the available seats will be considered for allotment.

ONLINE PAYMENT FOR ADMISSION

- Candidates will be informed about the schedule of online payment for admission along with the provisional allotment list and within that schedule date & time candidates will have to pay the admission fee online.
- Please check once again the eligibility criteria for applied programme before you make payment for admission. If any candidate fails to satisfy the eligibility criteria, his/her admission will be cancelled and there will be no refund of fees.
- After paying the fees online candidates have to print the payment receipt.
- In case candidates failed to pay the admission fees then, his/her candidature will be cancelled.
- At any stage of time if any discrepancy is found, the admission of the candidate will be cancelled and there will be no refund of fees.

- 9. PC/PwD certificate in original (if applicable).
- 10. Migration certificate for (Other State candidates (UG programmes) and all PG candidates if he/she previously studied in any another University.)
- 11. Transfer certificate or college leaving certificate issued by the college. No other certificate in lieu of this will be accepted (if applicable).
- 12. Character certificate to be obtained on the college letter head/pad, no other certificate in lieu of this will be accepted.
- 13. Residential proof (Voter Card/Aadhar Card)/Residential certificate from competent authority.
- 14. Physical Fitness certificate (only for Nursing candidates): Candidates have to submit a Physical Fitness Certificate from a registered medical practitioner in the prescribed format (this will be made available on Aliah University website: www.aliah.ac.in)

They will be admitted only if they have physically fit to pursuing the programme of study at Aliah University.

AT ANY STAGE IN THE ADMISSION PROCESS IF ANY DISCREPANCY IS FOUND, IF THE CANDIDATE FAILS TO SATISFY THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA THE ADMISSION OF THE CANDIDATE WILL BE CANCELLED AND THERE WILL BE NO REFUND OF ANY FEES.

ALL ADMISSION WILL BE PROVISIONAL. ADMISSION THROUGH AUAT 2022 WILL STAND CANCELLED IF THE CANDIDATE FAILS TO SATISFY THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AT ANY STAGE.

ALL ADMISSIONS ARE SUBJECT TO VERIFICATION OF PARTICULARS FROM THE ORIGINAL MARK SHEET/GRADE CARD AND OTHER DOCUMENTS OF THE CANDIDATE.

28. RESERVATION OF SEATS:

28.1. Physically Challenged (Pc) Candidates / Person with Disability (Pwd)

4 % seats are reserved for candidates belonging to the PC/PwD category, who are otherwise fit to pursue any programme. For any category of disability (viz., orthopedic, visual, speech, and/or hearing), benefit would be given to those candidates who have at least 40 % permanent physical impairment in relation to a body part/system/extremity/extremities/whole body, etc.

The candidates in this category will be required to submit a certificate of impairment from the competent authority.

NB: After the last counselling if any reserved seat/seats remain vacant, the University will fill up the vacant seat/seats from GEN category strictly from the merit list or vice versa.

28.2. For Nursing: for disabled candidates:

5% Disability reservation to be considered with a disability of locomotor to the tune of 40% to 50% of the lower extremity and other eligibility criteria with regard to age and qualification will be same as prescribed for nursing programme.

Further, it has also been resolved by INC that a committee to be framed considering of medical officers authorized by medical board of the State Government and a Nursing Expert in the panel which may decide whether the candidates have the disability of locomotor of 40% to 50%.

28.3. General:

The category of a candidate other than PC/PwD and is hereby termed as gen category.

NB: After the last counselling if any reserved seat/seats remain vacant, the University will fill up the vacant seats from PC category strictly from the merit list & vice versa

28.4. Students from Jammu & Kashmir:

Students from Jammu & Kashmir may take admission in Aliah University under Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS) in 2022-23. 10 supernumerary seats are available in B.Tech. Programmes with a limit of two seats per branch and 10% supernumerary seats are available in B.Sc. Nursing programme.

28.5. Students from WBJEE (For B.Tech. only)

20% of the seats in each of 4-year B. Tech. Programmes are reserved for candidates from WBJEE-2022 merit list.

- **28.6.** Students from JELET (for lateral entry to the 2nd year of B. Tech. Programmes only)
- **28.7.** For all the Post Graduate programmes except 2 year M.A. in Education, 80% seats will be reserved for internal candidates and 20% seats will be reserved for external candidates.
- **28.8.** In 2-year M.A. in Journalism and Mass Communication the division of seats are 50% for BA JMC/Media Science/Film Studies, 25% for Science/Engineering and 25% for Humanities/Social Sciences.
- **28.9.** The seats reserved for internal candidates may be filled from the list of external candidates if the list of internal candidates exhaust and vice-versa.

29. MERIT &CORE CALCULATION:

Merit calculation will be solely on Aliah University Admission Test score except for 2-year B.Ed. programme.

For B.Ed programme, Final merit score will be calculated based on academic score and admission test score.

30. ENTRANCE TEST CENTRE:

Possible Test Venues:

- 1. **AUAT-2022** for 4 year B.Sc. in Nursing and 2 year B.Ed programme will be conducted only at Kolkata Centre (Aliah University Campus/Campuses).
- 2. **AUAT-2022** for other UG programme will be conducted only at a few strategically located towns in West Bengal as listed below. Candidates has to choose any two centres as first and second choice.
