- b. Health and Nutrition of Muslim Children: Cross sectional study (SGD 3)
- c. Prevalence and Determinants of NCDs and CDs among Muslim population
- d. Mortality and Morbidity of Muslim population: Inter and Intra group analysis
- e. Role of Sasthya Sathi achieving SDG3 among Muslims

C. Work participation and employment of Muslim Community in West Bengal

- a. Representation of minority women in roles such as ICDS and Asha workers (SDG 5)
- b. Work participation among Muslim population: A gender focused study
- c. Unemployment and Migration: Spatial and temporal study

- (4) Originality Report of the project proposal (preferably from Turnitin) (Note: similarity will not exceed 10%)
