Aliah University Annual Anti-Ragging Report

Academic Year: 2023-2024

Aliah University is dedicated to creating a safe, inclusive atmosphere for all students, upholding a strict zero-tolerance stance on ragging in alignment with UGC guidelines and applicable legal standards. The Anti-Ragging Committee led an orientation session specifically for new students, emphasizing the university's anti-ragging policies and the importance of a respectful campus culture.

To reinforce this commitment, the university marked Anti-Ragging Day on August 12, 2024, and observed Anti-Ragging Week from August 12 to August 18, 2024, featuring displays of posters and banners across the campus to promote awareness about the consequences of ragging. Additionally, all students and their guardians completed affidavits pledging adherence to anti-ragging guidelines. Surveillance measures, including CCTV in key campus areas, further support a safe environment, while each department appointed a faculty mentor to guide and support incoming students. A dedicated email has also been set up to ensure that any incidents can be promptly reported.

These initiatives have been pivotal in fostering a ragging-free environment, and the Anti-Ragging Committee remains committed to enhancing its efforts and implementing new resources to maintain this standard of safety and inclusivity.

Total Incidents Reported in Academic Year 2023-2024 isthree and summary of incidents are

- 1. A complaint has been received from the UGC Anti-Ragging Cell to the University (Complaint No. WB_0135 dated 20th May 2023) on 20th May 2023. Student of M.A. Islamic Theology has complained against students of M.A. 2nd year of Islamic Studies and M.A. 2nd year of Islamic Theology of Aliah University. On 24.08.2023 the Anti-Ragging Committee submitted a report to the UGC Anti-Ragging Cell. They approved the report.
- A complaint was received from the UGC Anti-Ragging Cell to the University on 26th September 2023 (Complaint No. WB_0192 dated 26th September 2023). The Anti-Ragging Committee processed the complaint and sent the report to the UGC Anti-

- Ragging Cell on 29.11.23 and the complaint (ARCC/WB 6823) was closedby the UGC Anti-Ragging Cell.
- 3. A complaint was received from the UGC Anti-Ragging Cell to the University on 25thJanuary 2024 (Complaint No. WB_0230 dated 25thJanuary 2024). The Anti-Ragging Committee processed the complaint and sent the report to the UGC Anti-Ragging Cell on 07.02.2024 and the complaint (WB_0230) was closed by the UGC Anti-Ragging Cell.

Anti-Ragging Day/Week Celebration Report, 2024

Date: 12th to 18th August 2024 **Venue:** Aliah University, Kolkata

Organized by: Aliah University Anti-Ragging Cell

Introduction

In alignment with the University Grants Commission's (UGC) directives, Aliah University, Kolkata, observed Anti-Ragging Day/Week from 12th to 18th August 2024. The purpose of this observance was to raise awareness about the dangers of ragging, its social risks, and the legal consequences of participating in such activities. The event was aimed at fostering a safe and ragging-free environment on campus.

Objectives

- To educate students about the severe repercussions of ragging.
- To create a ragging-free campus by promoting awareness among both senior and junior students.
- To engage students in activities that highlight the importance of respect and dignity in peer interactions.

Activities and Events

Throughout the week, a series of activities and competitions were organized by the Aliah University Anti-Ragging Cell, all cantered around the theme of 'Anti-Ragging'. The events were designed to actively involve students in the campaign against ragging. The following activities were conducted:

3. Logo Designing Competition:

o The winning design will be used in future anti-ragging campaigns at the university.

4. Documentary Screening:

As part of the Anti-Ragging Day/Week celebration at Aliah University, a special documentary screening from UGC anti-ragging websites, was organized to raise awareness about the severe impact of ragging on students and the importance of maintaining a ragging-free campus. The documentary aimed to educate students on the emotional, social, and legal consequences of ragging, while also promoting empathy, respect, and camaraderie among peers. The screening was attended by students, faculty members, and administrative staff of Aliah University. Both senior and junior students were encouraged to participate. The documentary screening during the Anti-Ragging Day/Week celebration at Aliah University was a significant educational tool that reinforced the university's commitment to eradicating ragging. By showcasing the serious consequences of ragging and promoting a message of solidarity and support, the event played a crucial role in encouraging students to take a stand against ragging and contribute to a safe and inclusive campus environment.

5. Awarenesses sessions for promoting ragging free environment.

Promoting a ragging-free environment in educational institutions like Aliah University is crucial for ensuring a safe and inclusive atmosphere for students. Organizing three awareness sessions—on 13th August at the Park Circus campus girls' hostel, on 14th August at the Newtown campus girls' hostel, and on 16th August at the Newtown campus boys' hostel—are effective steps toward achieving this. During these sessions, anti-ragging leaflets were distributed to every student, and a member of the anti-ragging committee delivered a speech on the importance of maintaining a ragging-free environment.

Participation

The events received a positive response, with both senior and junior students actively participating. The involvement of students in these activities not only promoted a sense of unity and mutual respect but also underscored the importance of maintaining a safe and inclusive campus environment.

Award Ceremony

During the student induction program, the winners of the various competitions were honoured. Certificates of Merit and Prizes were awarded to the top performers, while Certificates of Participation were distributed to all participants. This ceremony served as a platform to recognize and encourage the students' efforts in contributing to the anti-ragging cause.

Conclusion

The Anti-Ragging Day/Week celebration at Aliah University was a significant step toward eliminating ragging from the campus. The activities conducted during the week effectively conveyed the message that ragging has no place in the university and that all students must

work together to ensure a safe and respectful academic environment. The event will be observed annually to reinforce these values and continue the university's commitment to a ragging-free campus.
