Aliah University is a State University under the Department of Minority Affairs and Madrasah Education, Government of West Bengal. It came into existence through the Aliah University Act (Act XXVII of 2007) passed by the West Bengal Legislative Assembly. The Act came into force on 5 April 2008. The University started its glorious journey in the 2008-09 academic sessions. This University plays a leading role in the advancement of higher education, especially for the Minority communities who have for various historical reasons remained socially and educationally backward. The spirit of Aliah University engraved in its motto, 'Advancement of Education and Culture' is very significant, and suggestive, and breaks all the barriers that come to acquiring modern and scientific education. It urges its students to an unabating quest for acquiring higher education along with creating sensible human beings with embedded cultural and ethical values.

The Aliah University has approvals from statutory bodies like the University Grant Commission (UGC), the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), the National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE), the Indian Nursing Council (INC) and the West Bengal Nursing Council (WBNC). The University has three (3) campuses and through its 23 academic departments, it offers 51 academic programmes. The present intake capacity is 1120 students at the postgraduate level and 1526 students at the undergraduate level. Research programmes in various disciplines are also being pursued actively

and there is immense scope for progress in the near future. So far over 742 research scholars have enrolled in various subjects out of which 236 scholars have been awarded Ph.D. degrees. Apart from offering various academic programmes in Science, Engineering, Language, Social Sciences, and Journalism we also offer professional programmes like LL.M, Nursing, and B.Ed.

4. Historical Background

Aliah University has a unique pre-history. A brief look at this will offer an understanding of its social and cultural importance. Its parent institution Aliah Madrasah was the first government-funded educational institution in British India, established by the British Governor-General Warren Hastings in 1780. The chief intention for establishing this institution was to educate the children of Muslim families in Arabic, Persian and Muslim Law so that they might be eligible to get jobs in different Government Departments like revenue administration and the judiciary. However, within a decade the curriculum of Aliah Madrasah had also encompassed modern subjects like Arithmetic, Geometry, Astronomy and the Natural Sciences along with the more traditional branches of learning like Law, Theology, Elementary Grammar, Philosophy and Logic. In 1821, the Annual Examination of the Madrasah was held in the presence of many respectable officials and gentlemen of Calcutta. This was the first public examination held in British India. A medical class, headed by Dr. Peter Breton, Professor of Medicine, was started at this Madrasah in 1826 for the first time in British India. Dr. Breton was authorized to purchase a skeleton and collect medical books. An anatomical work published by John Taylor was arranged to be translated into Arabic. The medical class continued here till the establishment of Calcutta Medical College in 1836. However, the students of the Madrasah were allowed to study medicine at Calcutta Medical College. This speaks for the high standard of education at the Madrasah in those days. English was first introduced at Aliah Madrasah in 1826, though the number of students was quite low as Persian was still medium of administration in British India. In 1854 at the recommendation of a Committee an English school, in the name of Anglo-Persian Department, was started under the direct control of the Principal of Calcutta Madrasah.

After the revolt of 1857, the British rulers began to have a suspicious attitude to the Muslims. There were proposals to abolish the Madrasah. However, in 1860, the Government of India, rejecting the idea of abolition, rather recommended improvement in its management. So the

Madrasah continued to exist. Some reforms were introduced at the Calcutta Madrasah according to the suggestions of a committee consisting of C.H. Campbell, Commissioner of the Presidency Division, I. Sutcliff, Principal of Presidency College, and Nawab Abdul Latif, then a Deputy Magistrate. Further reforms were introduced at the recommendations of the Education Commission headed by W.W. Hunter in 1884. Nawab Abdul Latif and Justice Syed Amir Ali played a very important role in these reforms. In 1896 Elliot Hostel was founded, with funds raised out of donations from the public. In 1902 the Muslim Institute was established as a part and parcel of Calcutta Madrasah. The Principal of the Madrasah was ex-officio President and Treasurer of the Muslim Institute. Several committees and commissions were appointed in 1915, 1923, 1931, 1938-40, and 1946 for the improvement in the syllabi, curricula and all-round development of Madrasah education in Bengal, particularly of Calcutta Madrasah. After Partition in 1947, this institution again faced severe problems. According to the decision of the Separation Council, all books and manuscripts, assets and estates of the Aliah Madrasah were transferred to the Dhaka Madrasah. It was only at the initiative of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, the first Education Minister of independent India, that the institutional framework of Calcutta Madrasah was again set up and teaching restarted.

In 2001, the Government of West Bengal, under the direction of the eminent educationist and the then Governor of West Bengal and Bihar, Dr. A. R. Kidwai, formed a Madrasah Education Committee. This Committee presented its recommendations for the continued development and future excellence of Aliah Madrasah in 2002. Finally, the over-two-hundred-year-old institution was elevated to the status of a university in 2007. Aliah University — a State University under the Department of Minority Affairs and Madrasah Education, Government of West Bengal — came into existence through the Aliah University Act (Act XXVII of 2007) passed by the West Bengal Legislative Assembly. The Act came into force on 5th April 2008. Classes were being held in various rented buildings at Sector I and

Sector V of Salt Lake City, apart from the Heritage building at Haji Md Mohsin Square. In 2011 the Government of West Bengal led by Mamata Banerjee, the Hon'ble Chief Minister, allotted 20 acres of land at New Town and the foundation stone for the New Town Campus was laid by her on 15 December 2011. The newly-built building was inaugurated by her on 11 November 2014, National Education Day. By this time the G+ 9 building at Park Circus Campus was also completed. So, the academic and administrative activities of the university started at both these two new campuses from January 2015.

It may be observed that Aliah Madrasah from its early days imparted teaching in the traditional subject of Theology, and the Modern Sciences, Social Sciences, and Humanities. To keep alive this tradition of teaching, right from the start, Aliah University has offered courses in the traditional Islamic Theology and Arabic along with subjects like English, Bengali, History and Geography and many other branches of Science (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Statistics, Botany, Microbiology and Zoology) as well as Engineering (Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics and Communications, Computer Science and Engineering), Management and Business Administration, Nursing, and Journalism & Mass Communication. Keeping in mind the requirements of the employment sector in the 21st century, right from the start, great emphasis has been put on courses in the Sciences, Engineering, Technology and Management, so that students from the minority community become eligible and can compete for jobs in various sectors. In keeping with the great stress laid by the UGC on the Semester system of education and Letter Grade process of marking, Aliah University has adopted semesterization, credit system, continuous assessment, and letter grading from its inception. All UG curricula are running under CBCS pattern as per UGC from 2019-20 and 2020-21 academic sessions, and CBCS system is also introduced in all PG programmes from 2021-22 academic session. Since 2023, the University has adopted the Curriculum and Credit Framework (CCF), in line with NEP 2020, at its UG level.

8. Admission Procedure at a Glance

1 Online Application

Application must be submitted online through the Aliah University website (www.aliah.ac.in) within the specified time-frame.

2 Marks/Mark Sheet Upload

Marks/ mark sheets to be uploaded during the online application process, but candidates who are appearing in the qualifying examination and awaiting for final result, mark sheets/ documents to be uploaded before the stipulated date mentioned in the Aliah University website (www.aliah.ac.in).

3 Admit Card

Candidates have to download the admit card within the stipulated time. Examination venue and schedule will be mentioned in the admit card.

4 Admission Test

Admission test will be conducted for UG programmes in different centres across the state. However, admission test for Nursing, B.Ed. and PG programmes will be conducted in the Kolkata centre only. As per the Date, Time & Venue mentioned in the admit card, candidates have to appear for the Aliah University Admission Test (AUAT-2026).

5 Group discussion (GD)/ Personal Interview (PI)

Only for the 2 years Master of Business Administration (MBA), candidates will be shortlisted for the GD/PI based on their General Merit Rank (GMR). The final merit list will be incorporate scores from both the written examination and the interview process.

6 Provisional Merit List

Provisional Merit List/ Result will be published and candidates have to download the Rank Card by logging into the admission portal using his/her User Id & Password.

7 Counselling

Counselling will be held for programme codes U14 & U21 to select the specific programme/subject. Counselling will be held for programme codes U08 & P08 to select the study centre.

8 Provisional Allotment List

Provisional Allotment lists will be published on the scheduled dates (to be notified later). Candidates, who will be enlisted in the provisional allotment list, only can pay admission fees online.

9 Online Payment for Admission

Candidates enlisted in the provisional allotment list will be informed about the schedule of online payment for admission along with the provisional allotment list; and within that scheduled date & time candidates will have to pay the admission fees online.

10 Documents Verification /Final Admission

To complete the admission procedure, candidates have to be present physically at the specified venue to produce all required original documents, along with rank card and payment receipt. Venue, date and time for documents verification will be notified later.

9. Introduction



Aliah University Admission Test (AUAT) is a central admission process for conducting admission into various UG, PG & B.Ed courses in Aliah University. It is governed by AUAT Committee under the supervision of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor. The AUAT Committee shall function as an independent body for framing the norms regulating admission, admission procedures and finalizing the names of qualified candidates for admission.

Admission Test for all UG programmes will be conducted in different centres across the state. However, admission test for Nursing, B.Ed. and PG programmes will be conducted in the Kolkata centre only. Admission in various UG, PG & B.Ed (except GATE qualified candidates applying for M.Tech and 2 years Masters of Business Administration programmes) programmes will be taken solely on the basis of merit score of AUAT-2026 fulfilling other minimal eligibility criteria.

14.3. Training & Placement Activities

- 4) Arranging step by step Training Methodology to develop various employable skills including interview handling skills of the students.
- 5) Employing professional trainers from reputed training agencies to train the students through Mock Interviews, Aptitude Tests, Group Discussions, Online Tests, Personality Development Tests and HR Interview.
- 6) Organizing seminars and lectures periodically by eminent personalities from both academia and industries.
- 7) Arranging technical training by technical experts and industrial visits during semester breaks to get practical exposure.
- 8) Assisting the final year students in getting industry projects related to their domain.

17.3. Games & Sports

Relaxation under Sports Background: In each undergraduate academic course, a maximum of one candidate who has represented at the State or National level in sports may be considered for admission under the sports category and there will be no relaxation under the sports category shall be applicable for admission for professional courses, such as B.Ed. and B.Sc. in Nursing. Candidates under this category may be eligible for a relaxation of up to 5% in marks for admissible courses for the academic session 2026-27.

17.4. National Cadet Corps (NCC)



Aliah University strongly supports NCC training of the students, and provides basic infrastructure to groom them into disciplined and patriotic citizens, so that they can serve the nation from the frontiers. Students participate in the NCC training on a voluntary basis. While pursuing their regular course, NCC cadets undertake different training programs, such as drill, shooting, physical fitness, map reading, first aid, and camp training. Cadets also participate in LRDC camp every year. They obtain NCC -B and C certificates after successful completion of the training.

National Service Scheme (NSS) is a permanent youth Programme under the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India and funded by Government of West Bengal and Government of India. Since 2012, the NSS unit has been functioning with full vigour and enthusiasm in Aliah University.

B.Tech. (Honours): For advanced specialization within your parent department.

B.Tech. with Minor: To gain expertise in a subject area outside your primary department.

- **Learning Modality (NPTEL/SWAYAM)**

To provide flexibility and access to world-class content, all Minor courses will be pursued through the NPTEL/SWAYAM online platforms. No physical classes will be conducted by the departments for these specific courses. Each department will "float" a pool of 6 approved courses for students to choose from.

● Application Process & Timeline

Students can apply based on the criteria established by the University Committee (typically linked to academic performance). Candidate must submit your application in the prescribed format to your respective department within 15 days of the publication of your 1st-year results.

While the coursework is online, the evaluation follows the standard University format: Internal Assessment (20 Marks): University Examination (80 Marks): Conducted by Aliah University in the traditional end-semester format.

Age Relaxation for Sponsored Candidates (M.Tech. programmes)

Upper age limit for all M.Tech. programmes is 27 years (as on 1st July 2026). A maximum age relaxation of up to five years may be granted to candidates who meet the prescribed qualifying marks and entrance examination criteria and seek admission as full-time sponsored candidates, subject to the submission of supporting documents from the concerned institute or company.

- Part-II (30 Marks): Question will be on General Knowledge, General English and Islamic History & Culture (in the ratio of approximately 1:1:4)
- Question paper will consist of objective type multiple choice questions (MCQs). (Except for B.A. (Hons.)/M.A. in Bengali, English, Arabic, and M.A. in Journalism and Mass Communications).
- For B.A. (Hons.)/M.A. in Bengali, English, and Arabic, and M.A. in Journalism and Mass Communication, 56 marks will be from relevant subject and that will be objective type MCQ and rest 14 marks will be from relevant subject that will be descriptive type.
- Questions in all papers are to be answered on a specially designed machine gradable sheet (ORS-Optical Response Sheet) using black/blue ball point pen only.

23.2. Marks/ Marksheets Upload

- All the available seats will be considered for allotment.

AT ANY STAGE OF THE ADMISSION PROCESS IF ANY DISCREPANCY IS FOUND, AND IF THE CANDIDATE FAILS TO SATISFY THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA, THE ADMISSION OF THE CANDIDATE WILL BE CANCELLED AND THERE WILL BE NO REFUND OF ANY FEES.

23. Admission Procedure

23.9. Online Payment for Admission

- Candidates will be informed about the schedule of online payment for admission along with the provisional allotment list. Within that scheduled date & time candidates will have to pay the admission fees through online mode only.
- Candidates are advised to check once again the eligibility criteria for the applied programme before making payment for the admission. If any candidate fails to satisfy the eligibility criteria, his/her admission will be cancelled and there will be no refund of fees.
- After paying the fees online, candidates must have to take a printout of the payment receipt.
- In any case, if the candidate fails to pay the admission fee, his/her candidature will be cancelled.
- At any stage of admission procedure if any discrepancy is found, the admission of the candidate will be cancelled and there will be no refund of fees.

23.10. Documents Verification & Final Admission

- After paying the admission fees, candidates have to be present physically at the specified venue on the scheduled date and time, with photocopy of all the required documents, along with their originals for verification. Admission fee-payment-receipt also has to be submitted to complete the admission process.
- All admission will be provisional. Admission through AUAT-2026 will stand cancelled at any stage of the admission process if the candidate fails to satisfy the eligibility criteria.
- All admissions are subject to verification of particulars from the original admit card, original mark sheet/grade card and other documents of the candidates.
- During document-verification, if the personal data submitted by the candidate at the time of online registration/application is found to be false, his/her admission is liable to be cancelled.

23. Admission Procedure

Documents Required for Document-verification/Final Admission

The following documents in original & one set of self-attested photocopies are required at the time of final admission/document-verification

1. Confirmation Sheet/submitted application form.
2. Rank Card.
3. Payment receipt/admission fees receipt.
4. Recent passport size colour photograph.
5. Anti-ragging undertaking (format will be made available on Aliah University website: www.aliah.ac.in) of parent and candidate both in non-judicial Rs. 10 stamp paper duly affirmed in front of an Oath Commissioner.
6. All original Mark sheets & Certificates of class X, XII and Graduation (wherever applicable).
7. Admit card of 10th level.
8. Proof of age: 10th standard admit card/10th standard certificate/birth certificate.
9. PC/ Divyang/ PwD certificate in original (if applicable).
10. Migration certificate for Other-State candidates (UG programmes) and all PG candidates, if he/she has previously studied in any other University.
11. Transfer certificate or college leaving certificate issued by the college. No other certificate in lieu of this will be accepted.
12. Residential proof (Voter Card/Aadhaar Card).
13. Domicile Certificate in prescribed format for U21 & U22 programmes.
14. Physical Fitness certificate (only for B.Sc. in Nursing programme): Candidates have to submit a Physical Fitness Certificate from a registered medical practitioner in the prescribed format . Candidates will be allowed to take admission into B.Sc. Nursing programme only if they are found physically fit to pursue the programme at Aliah University.

N.B: Candidates are advised to follow University's website www.aliah.ac.in for regular updates.

23. Admission Procedure

Criteria for Residential/Domicile of West Bengal

Only those candidates will be treated as domicile of West Bengal who are either,

A) Residing in West Bengal continuously for at least 10 (ten) years as of 31.12.2025.

B) whose parent(s) is/are a permanent resident(s) of West Bengal having permanent address within the State of West Bengal. In the case of (A) above, a certificate is to be obtained as per proforma 'a1' or proforma 'a2'. In case of (B) above, a certificate is to be obtained in proforma 'b', or the candidate must produce in original any two of Voter ID card/Aadhaar card/Passport/Ration card belonging to his/her parents. The said documents must justify that the residential address of the parent(s) is/are in West Bengal.

Competent authority to issue domicile certificate

- a) Proforma 'a1' or 'b' must be signed and certified by any of the following competent authorities from the Central Government or State Government having local jurisdiction over the place of the permanent residence of the concerned candidate or his/her parent(s) viz.
1. District Magistrate, Additional District Magistrate, Deputy Magistrate, Deputy Collector, Sub Divisional Officer, Block Development Officer.
 2. Superintendent of Police, Additional Superintendent of Police, Sub Divisional Police Officer, Deputy Superintendent of Police,
 3. Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner, Assistant Commissioner of Police Commissionerate.
 4. Judicial Magistrate of any rank or position in the concerned district, Metropolitan locality, or Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta or Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
 5. Corporation Area Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, Assistant Commissioner.
 6. Assistant Secretary or above in the Secretariat to the Government of West Bengal (including GTA) or Central Government.
 7. Deputy Director or above in the Directorate to the Government of West Bengal or Central Government.
 8. Collector of Kolkata (Stamp and Revenue) located at 11, N.S. Road, Kolkata-700001 for the inhabitants under the jurisdiction of Kolkata Police Area.
 9. Officials issuing domicile certificates MUST provide their full name, designation, place of posting with address, and landline/mobile number. He/she should also provide his/her identity card number if available.
 10. Domicile certificates issued by any elected people's representative such as Municipal Commissioner, Councillor of Municipal Corporation/ Municipality, Member of a threetier Panchayat system or GTA, MLA or MP are unacceptable.
 11. Proforma 'a2' must be signed and certified by the Head of the Institution from which the candidate has passed or will appear in the 10+2 examination. Such a certificate must be issued after verifying the candidate's school education record.

24. Reservation of Seats

24.1. Physically Challenged (PC/ Divyang) Candidates /Person with Disability (PwD): 4 % seats are reserved for candidates belonging to the PC/ Divyang/ PwD category, who are otherwise fit to pursue any programme. For any category of disability (viz., orthopaedic, visual, speech, and/or hearing), benefit would be given to those candidates who have at least 40 % permanent physical impairment in relation to a body part/ system/extremity/extremities/ whole body, etc. The candidates in this category will be required to submit a certificate of impairment from the competent authority.

24.2. For Disabled/ Divyang candidates of Nursing programme: 5% Disability reservation to be considered with a disability of locomotor to the tune of 40% to 50% of the lower extremity and other eligibility criteria with regard to age and qualification will be same as prescribed for Nursing programme. Further, it has also been resolved by INC that a committee to be framed considering of medical officers authorized by medical board of the State Government and a Nursing Expert in the panel which may decide whether the candidates have the disability of locomotor of 40% to 50%.

NB: During admission process if any reserved seat/seats remain vacant, the University will fill up the vacant seats from PC/ Divyang/ PwD category strictly from the merit list, or vice versa.

24.3. General: The category of a candidate other than PC/ Divyang/ PwD and is hereby termed as General category.

NB: During admission process if any reserved seat/seats remain vacant, the University will fill up the vacant seat/seats from GEN category strictly from the merit list, or vice versa.

24.4. Students from Jammu, Kashmir and Ladakh: Students from Jammu, Kashmir and Ladakh may take admission in Aliah University under Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS) in 2026-27, 10 supernumerary seats are available in B.Tech. Programmes with a limit of two seats per branch and 10% supernumerary seats are available in B.Sc. Nursing programme.

24.5. Students from WBJEE (For B.Tech. only): 20% seats (12 seats in each branch) of B. Tech. Programmes are reserved for candidates from WBJEE-2026 merit list.

24.6. Students from JELET (for lateral entry to the 2nd year of B. Tech. Programmes only): 2 seats in each of B. Tech. Programmes are reserved for candidates with valid JELET rank.

N.B.: 80 % of general seats are reserved for domicile of West Bengal (Applicable for programme code U21 & U22). If reserved seats remain vacant, it will be filled up by the general candidates.

24.7. For all the Post Graduate programmes (except M.Tech., MJMC and M.A. in Education) 80% seats will be reserved for internal candidates.

For 2 year all M.Tech. programmes, 50% seats are reserved for GATE qualified candidates, 40 % seats are reserved for Internal Candidates. GATE qualified candidates are exempted from AUAT-2026.

For M.A. in Journalism and Mass Communication, the division of seats are 50% for B.A. in JMC/Media Science/Film Studies, 25% for Science/Engineering and 25% for Humanities/Social Sciences.

For 2 years M.A. in Education, 80% seats are reserved for the candidates having B.A. Hons. in Education and 20% seats are reserved for the internal candidates who have passed B.Ed. degree from Aliah University. **The seats may be filled from the list of external applicants if the list of internal applicants exhaust and vice-versa.**

25. Merit Score Calculation

Merit calculation for admission to all the Undergraduate, Postgraduate and B.Ed. programmes will be solely on the basis of Aliah University Admission Test (AUAT) - 2026 score except M.Tech. (for GATE qualified candidates) and 2 year MBA programmes.

For 2 year M.Tech. programmes, GATE qualified candidates are exempted from AUAT-2026 and final ranking will be calculated based on the valid GATE scores only.

For the 2 year Master of Business Administration (MBA) programme, candidates will be short-listed according to General Merit Rank (GMR) for Group Discussion (GD)/ Personal Interview (PI). The final merit rank will be incorporate scores from both the written examination and the interview process.

26. Entrance Test Centres

Probable Aliah University Admission Test - 2026 Venues:

1. Aliah University Admission Test (AUAT)-2026 for all UG programmes except Nursing will be conducted only at a few strategically located towns in West Bengal. Candidates have to choose any two centres as first and second choice.
 2. Aliah University Admission Test (AUAT)-2026 for B.Sc. in Nursing and B.Ed. programme will be conducted only at Kolkata Centre.
 3. Aliah University Admission Test (AUAT)-2026 for all PG programmes will be conducted only at Kolkata Centre.
- Final decision regarding allotment of the Entrance Test/Examination Centre for AUAT-2026 will be taken by the competent authority.
 - Request for change of Entrance Test/Examination-centre at any stage will not be entertained.
