HISTORICAL BACKGROUND OF ALIAH UNIVERSITY

Aliah University has a unique pre-history. A brief look at this will offer an understanding of its social and cultural importance. Its parent institution Aliah Madrasah was the first government-funded educational institution in British India, established by the British Governor-General Warren Hastings in 1780. The chief intention for establishing this institution was to educate the children of Muslim families in Arabic, Persian and Muslim Law so that they might be eligible to get jobs in different Government Departments like revenue administration and the judiciary. However, within a decade the curriculum of Aliah Madrasah had also encompassed modern subjects like arithmetic, geometry, astronomy and the natural sciences along with the more traditional branches of learning like Law, Theology, Elementary Grammar, Philosophy and Logic. In 1821, the Annual Examination of the Madrasah was held in the presence of many respectable officials and gentlemen of Calcutta. This was the first public examination held in British India. A medical class, headed by Dr Peter Breton, Professor of Medicine, was started at this Madrasah in 1826 for the first time in British India. Dr Breton was authorized to purchase a skeleton and collect medical books. An anatomical work published by John Taylor was arranged to be translated into Arabic. The medical class continued here till the establishment of Calcutta Medical College in 1836. However, the students of the Madrasah were allowed to study medicine at Calcutta Medical College. This speaks for the high standard of education at the Madrasah in those days. English was first introduced at Aliah Madrasah in 1826, though the number of students was quite low as Persian was still medium of administration in British India. In 1854 at the recommendation of a Committee an English school, in the name of Anglo-Persian Department, was started under the direct control of the Principal of Calcutta Madrasah. After the Revolt of 1857, the British rulers began to have a suspicious attitude to the Muslims. There were proposals to abolish the Madrasah. However, in 1860, the Government of India, rejecting the idea of abolition, rather recommended improvement in its management. So the Madrasah continued to exist. Some reforms were introduced at the Calcutta Madrasah according to the suggestions of a committee consisting of C.H. Campbell, Commissioner of the Presidency Division, I. Sutcliff, Principal of Presidency College, and Nawab Abdul Latif, then a Deputy Magistrate. Further reforms were introduced at the recommendations of the Education Commission headed by W.W. Hunter in 1884. Nawab Abdul Latif and Justice Syed Amir Ali played a very important role in these reforms. In 1896 Elliot Hostel was founded, with funds raised out of donations from the public. In 1902 the Muslim Institute was established as a part and parcel of Calcutta Madrasah. The Principal of the Madrasah was ex-officio President and Treasurer of the Muslim Institute. Several committees and commissions were appointed in 1915, 1923, 1931, 1938-40, and 1946 for the improvement in the syllabi, curricula and all-round development of Madrasah education in Bengal, particularly of Calcutta Madrasah. After Partition in 1947, this institution again faced severe problems. According to the decision of the Separation Council, all books and manuscripts, assets and estates of the Aliah Madrasah were transferred to the Dhaka Madrasah. It was only at the initiative of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad, the first Education Minister of independent India, that the institutional framework of Calcutta Madrasah was again set up and teaching restarted.

In 2001, the Government of West Bengal, under the direction of the eminent educationist and the then Governor of West Bengal and Bihar, Dr. A. R. Kidwai, formed a Madrasah Education Committee. This Committee presented its recommendations for the continued development and future excellence of Aliah Madrasah in 2002. Finally, the over-two-hundred-year-old institution was elevated to the status of a university in 2007. Aliah University — a State University under the Department of Minority Affairs and Madrasah Education, Government of West Bengal — came into existence through the Aliah University Act (Act XXVII of 2007) passed by the West Bengal Legislative Assembly. The Act came into force on 5th April 2008. Classes were being held in various rented buildings at Sector I and Sector V of Salt Lake City, apart from the Heritage building at Haji Md Mohsin Square. In 2011 the Government of West Bengal led by Mamata Banerjee, the Hon'ble Chief Minister, allotted 20 acres of land at New Town and the foundation stone for the

New Town Campus was laid by her on 15 December 2011. The newly-built building was inaugurated by her on 11 November 2014, National Education Day. By this time the G+ 9 building at Park Circus Campus was also completed. So, the academic and administrative activities of the university started at both these two new campuses from January 2015.

It may be observed that Aliah Madrasah from its early days imparted teaching in the traditional subject of theology, and the modern sciences, social sciences, and humanities. To keep alive this tradition of teaching, right from the start, Aliah University has offered courses in the traditional Islamic Theology and Arabic along with subjects like English, Bengali, History and Geography and many other branches of Science (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Statistics, Botany, Microbiology, and Zoology) as well as Engineering (Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics and Communications, Computer Science and Engineering), Management and Business Administration, Nursing, and Journalism & Mass Communication. Keeping in mind the requirements of the employment sector in the 21st century, right from the start, great emphasis has been put on courses in the Sciences, Engineering, Technology and Management, so that students from the minority community become eligible and can compete for jobs in various sectors. In keeping with the great stress laid by the UGC on the Semester system of education and Letter Grade process of marking, Aliah University has adopted semesterization, credit system, continuous assessment, and letter grading from its inception. All UG curricula are running under CBCS pattern as per UGC from 2019-20 and 2020-21 academic sessions, and CBCS system is also introduced in all PG programmes from 2021-22 academic session.

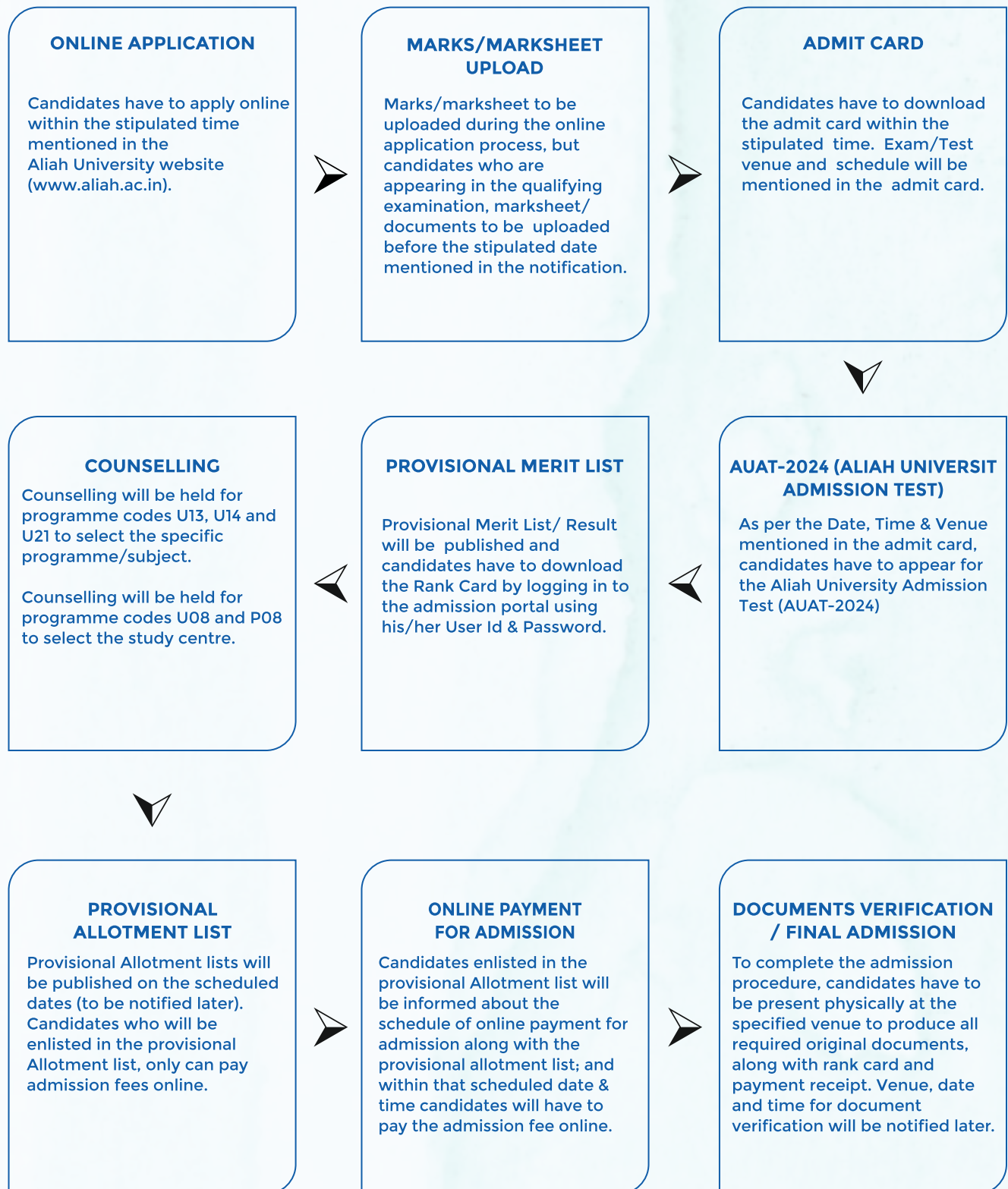

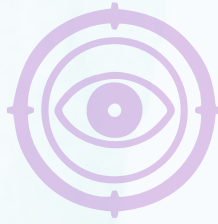
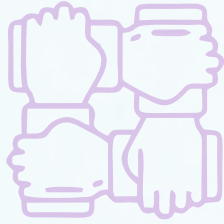

Aliah University Admission Test (AUAT-2024) will be conducted for all UG, PG & B.Ed. programmes. Admission Test will be conducted in different centres across the state. Admission in various UG & PG programmes will be taken on the basis of merit score of Aliah University Admission Test fulfilling other eligibility criteria. However, admission in B.Ed. programme will be taken through merit score calculated from the score of Aliah University Admission Test along with the academic score of the candidates fulfilling other eligibility criteria.

9. Training and Placement

Aliah University has a full-fledged Training & Placement Cell (T&P Cell) which is under the supervision of Training and Placement Officer to provide placement assistance to the students. It conducts special training sessions for the students to develop their soft skills and english language communication skills and also help them to prepare for aptitude test, group discussion, personal interview and mock test which is required for the enhancement of employability of the students to meet the industry requirement. 9.2. Training & Placement Activities

The major activities of the Training & Placement Cell :

- I. Developing strong network between the University and the corporate world.
- II. Arranging on and off campus placement drives.
- III. Organizing pool - campus drive at Aliah University.
- IV. Employing professional trainers from reputed training agencies to train the students through Mock Interviews, Aptitude Tests, Group Discussions, Online Tests, Personality Development Tests and HR Interview.
- V. Organizing seminars and lectures periodically by eminent personalities from both academia and industries.
- VI. Arranging technical training program and industrial visits during semester breaks to get practical exposure.
- VII. Providing assistance to the final year students in getting internships and industry level projects related to their domains.

Beside that students are also undergoing some short term vocational training in their last few semesters. Aiming to place the maximum number of students through On-Campus, Off- Campus and Pooled-Campus interviews, the T&P Cell helps the students in getting practical exposure through internship programmes related to their domain.

Training & Placement Cell has always encouraged the students to capitalize on the semester breaks and vacations to enhance their industrial exposure. They have gone through training programmes of various

It has signed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with many government and corporate organizations, some of them are NSIC, MSME, Edunet Foundation, Krackin Skill, Ardent, Bassetti Pvt. Ltd.

Aliah University is a one of the network institute of Indian Institute of Remote Sensing (IIRS) under Indian Space Research Organization, Department of Space, Govt. of India, and outreach programmes for training and academic online courses.

10. Innovation and Start-up Culture

Institution Innovation Council (IIC), Aliah University is established to promote the culture of innovation and entrepreneurship in the university. Throughout the year, IIC regularly organizes seminars, workshops, Hackathons etc mainly for mentoring and motivating students to develop the innovation-incubation-startup ecosystem among the student and faculty members. In the short span of time Aliah University is ranked among "Band promising" category of NIRF-Innovation (ARIIA) ranking. Our students are showing their beautiful minds by competing in projects, ideation and hackathon challenges. Two groups have qualified for Grand Finale of prestigious Smart India Hackathon (SIH-2023).

11. Research and Development

Faculty members, research scholars and students are engaged in high end research and scholarly activities in Aliah University. A good number of quality research articles are constantly being published in National and International level peer reviewed journals and conferences in all the fields of Engineering, Science and Humanities & Social science areas. Faculty members are also involved in sponsored research projects funded by various Government and Corporate sectors e.g. SERB, DST, UGC-DAE CSR, ICSSR (Indian Council of Social Science Research), IITs, Hewlett Packard, IBM, Microsoft etc. Faculty members also engaged in various collaborative research and fellowship programs with prestigious national and international institutions like IITs, ISI, IICB, JU, Franhauser IIS, Erlangen, Bielefeld University, Germany, University of Warsaw, Poland, Delft University, The Netherlands, University of Tokyo, NUS, Singapore, and National Taiwan University, Taiwan etc.

12. Facilities for Students

12.1. Hostel

At present, The University has:

- One G+19 Boys' Hostel with accommodation for 661 boarders.
- One G+13 Girls' Hostel with accommodation for 437 boarders.
- Park Circus Campus has a G+9 Hostel for Girls that has accommodation capacity for 208 girl students.



12.2. Library

Aliah University has the state-of-the-art library facility for offline and online academic resources.

The University libraries have a rich repository of 78,000 books in different disciplines and provide comprehensive access to books, journals, magazines, white papers, reports, e-journals/online databases, e-books, and dissertations to scholars, students, officers and non-teaching staff. The Library in the Newtown campus deals with STEM (Engineering & Technology, Management, Pure Science and Biological Sciences) area while the library in Park Circus campus covers the collection on Humanities, Social Science, Nursing, Law, Education etc. The age-old heritage library is situated at Taltala campus has an authentic collection of books on Islamic Theology and Islamic Studies. Both New Town and Park Circus campus libraries are automated.



12.3. Games And Sports

Sports undoubtedly have become an integral part of our education system with an aim to support sports men to gain their quality education. Sports Board of Aliah University also strongly supports the idea of giving quality games-and-sports facility and opportunities to the students to excel both in academics *vis-a-vis* sports. Aliah University is a member of Association of Indian Universities (AIU), Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Govt. Students from this university regularly participate in inter-university and inter-college competitions.



12.4. National Cadet Corps (NCC)

Aliah University strongly supports NCC training of the students, and provides basic infrastructure to groom them into disciplined and patriotic citizens, so that they can serve the nation from the frontiers. Students participate in the NCC training on a voluntary basis. While pursuing their regular course, NCC cadets undertake different training programs, such as drill, shooting, physical fitness, map reading, first aid, and camp training. 12.5. National Service Scheme (NSS)

National Service Scheme popularly known as NSS, the scheme was launched in Mahatma Gandhi Centenary year 1969 and aimed at developing student's personality through community service. The overall objective of National Service is educational. This objective is attained through the service to the community. The process of learning is not only a desirable supplement to the classroom education but develops in the student a sense of responsibility, tolerance and cooperation. The NSS plays a vital role in the development of the latent aspects of the student's personality. National Service Scheme (NSS) is a permanent youth Programme under the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India and funded by Government of West Bengal and Government of India. Since 2012, the NSS unit has been functioning with full vigour and enthusiasm in Aliah University.



12.6. Scholarship

It is for information of all candidates admitted through AUAT-2024 of all courses that Aliah University has no institute scholarship of its own. However, eligible students may apply for other scholarships/fellowships as and when applications are invited by the Government or any other sponsoring agency. The university will only verify and help in submitting the documents of the students for scholarship.

(As M. Tech. courses run by the Aliah University are not approved by the AICTE, no MHRD/GATE scholarship is available to the admitted students.)

- Candidates without UG or PG in the above ten method subject will be eligible to apply for any one of the above subject as the first method if they have studied at least 200 marks in the subject at the graduation level with at least 50% marks in aggregate.
- Those applying in Physical Science as the method subject should have studied either Physics or Chemistry as a subject of at least 200 Marks at the Graduation level.
- Candidates having 50% marks in B.Sc. /M.Sc. in Biological Sciences shall be eligible to apply in Physical Science as the first method subject provided that the candidate has studied Physics/Chemistry as a subject of at least 200 marks at the Graduation level.
- Candidates having 55% marks UG/PG in Engineering & Technology shall be eligible to apply in Physical Science as the first method subject provided that the candidate has studied Physics/Chemistry as a subject of at least 200 marks at the graduation level.
- Candidates having 50 % marks in UG/PG in Statistics or Economics shall be eligible to apply in Mathematics as the method subject provided that a candidate has studied Mathematics as a subject of at least 200 Marks at the Graduation level.
- Candidates having 50 % marks in UG/PG in Education shall be eligible to apply in History/ Geography/ any language subject as the method subject provided that a candidate has studied that subject of at least 200 marks at the Graduation level.
- Candidates having 50 % marks in UG/PG in Islamic Studies shall be eligible to apply in Islamic Theology / History / any language subject as the method subject provided that a candidate has studied that subject of at least 200 marks at the Graduation level.

Notes for B.Ed. Programme

1. Intake Capacity of Deputed candidate from recognized High Madrasah and Sr. Madrasah of West Bengal and Other University, as per the table mentioned earlier.
2. For fresher candidates, in case of Honours Graduate, the marks obtained in Honours Subject will be considered. In case of General Graduates, the total marks obtained in General/Subsidiary/Pass subjects will be considered.
3. If seat(s) reserved for any particular category remains vacant, it will be filled up by other category of same method subject or may be transferred to other method subject as may be deemed fit by competent authority.

(It is mandatory for a candidate to appear for both the entrance test and documents verification process.)

14. Age Limit (As on 1st July, 2024)

Upper age limit for undergraduate programmes is 22 years except for the following

B.A. Honours in Islamic Theology and B.A. Honours in Islamic Studies, Lateral entry into 2nd Year of B.Tech. Programmes -25 Years.

No upper age limit for B.Sc. in Nursing programme (Minimum age limit of 17 Years as on 31st December, 2024)

Upper age limit for Postgraduate programmes is 25 years except for the following

M.Tech. programmes -27 years

M.A. in Islamic Theology, Islamic Studies and B.Ed. programme-30 years

M.A. in Education-32 years

No upper age limit for LL.M. programme

Though the upper age limit is mentioned above, all the applicants applying for Undergraduate and Postgraduate programmes who have passed qualifying examination before 2022 are not eligible to take admission in the year 2024 except for LL.M. and Nursing programme.

15. Internal Candidate

Only those candidates who will complete the qualifying degree from Aliah University in the year 2024, and those who have already completed the same from Aliah University (not earlier than 2022) and have not migrated to any other institution, will be considered as internal candidates.

16. Important Notes

- For undergraduate programmes all the qualifying examinations should be from any recognized Councils/Boards/Madrasah board, such as West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Examination (WBCHSE), West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education (WBBME), Central Board of Secondary Education (New Delhi) (CBSE), Council for Indian School Certificate Examination (ISC), etc.
- Intermediate or two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by a recognized Board/University.
- Final Examination of the two-year course of the Joint Services Wing of the National Defence Academy.
- Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) with a minimum of five subjects, or H.S. Examination Conducted by W.B. Council of Rabindra Open Schooling.
- At any stage in the admission process if any discrepancy is found, and if the candidate fails to satisfy the eligibility criteria, the admission of the candidate will be cancelled and there will be no refund of any fees.
- All admission will be provisional admission through AUAT-2024 and subject to verification of particulars from the original mark sheet/grade card and other documents of the candidate.
- Those who are appearing for the qualifying examinations in the year 2024 may also apply for admission. However, they have to fulfil other admission criteria for the respective subjects, and have to submit the mark sheet before preparation of the merit list / taking provisional admission.
- Candidates are cautioned against falling prey to any assurance/offer by any individual/agency for all sorts of admission to Aliah University. No donation or capitation fee is required to be paid for admission to any programme offered by the university.
- All dates are tentative and subject to change. Candidates are advised to follow University's website www.aliah.ac.in for regular updates.

17. Pattern of AUAT – 2024

- Question paper of AUAT-2024 will be of 100 marks and examination duration will be of 2 Hours.
- Part-I (70 Marks): Question will be from respective subject. (Refer to the point number 18 for detail syllabus).
- Part-II (30 Marks): Question will be on General Knowledge, General English and Islamic History & culture (in the ratio of approximately 1:1:4)
- Question paper will consist of objective type multiple choice questions (MCQs). (Except for B.A. (Hons.)/M.A. in Bengali, English, Arabic, and M.A. in Journalism and Mass Communications). For B.A. (Hons.)/M.A. in Bengali, English, and Arabic, and M.A. in Journalism and Mass Communication, 56 marks will from relevant subject and that will be objective type MCQ and rest 14 marks will from relevant subject that will be descriptive type.
- Questions in all papers are to be answered on a specially designed machine gradable sheet (ORS-Optical Response Sheet) using black/blue ball point pen only.

18. Syllabi

Syllabus for Core Subjects

- All B.Tech. and BCA will be comprised of Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics as per syllabi of classes XI & XII of West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education (WBCHSE) and Equivalent.
- Lateral entry to the 2nd Year of B.Tech. Programmes will comprise of Engineering Mathematics, Basic Computer Science, Strength of Material, Engineering Mechanics, Environmental Engineering, Basic Electrical Technology and Basic Electronics Engineering.
- Integrated MBA (BBA - MBA) programme will be on basic of Mathematics, verbal and non-verbal reasoning, Commercial Arithmetic and elementary knowledge in concerned area.
- All UG programmes (except Arabic, Urdu, Islamic Theology and Islamic studies) will be comprised of concerned subject as per syllabi of classes XI & XII of West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education (WBCHSE) and Equivalent.
- Nursing Programme will comprise of Biology, Chemistry & Physics as per syllabus of JENPARH/JENPAUH, West Bengal.
- Honours in Arabic and Urdu comprise as per Arabic and Urdu syllabi of H.S. or equivalent examination.
- B.A. Hons. in Islamic Theology and Islamic Studies comprise as per syllabi of Fazil according to West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education (WBBME).
- B.Sc.(Hons.) in Statistics as per syllabus of classes XI & XII of Mathematics of H.S. of WBCHSE
- Masters programmes excluding MJMC & MCA will be on concerned subject.
- MJMC will be on English, Concept of Language and Literature, Fundamentals of Journalism and Mass Communication having its role as forth pillar of Indian Democracy, Sports and Cinema.
- MCA programme will be comprised of Reasoning, Quantitative Aptitude, Data Interpretation, Problem Solving Questions, Discrete Quantitative Analysis and Basic Mathematics.
- For LL.M. Programme -based on LL.B. programme of recognized University.
- For B.Ed. Programme syllabus will be comprised of Reasoning, Teaching aptitude, General Knowledge, and Current Affairs.

Syllabus for General English, General Knowledge, Islamic History & Culture

- General English: Basic knowledge of vocabularies, grammar and comprehension of 10+2 level.
- General knowledge: This will be comprised of History (Medieval and Modern India), Geography, Political Science, General Science and Current Affairs.
- Islamic History & Culture: This will be based on 10+2 level.

19. Admission Procedure

The admission procedure at Aliah University is a rigorous, multi-layered and transparent process. The applicants can apply online through the University website. The entire process has several stages. Selection and admission of the candidates in Aliah University is based on the following steps.

19.1. Online Application

- All candidates willing to take admission in Aliah University must apply through online mode of application only. Link and detailed instruction will be given in the Aliah University website (www.aliah.ac.in) on the scheduled date.
- Candidates are advised to follow the Application Guidelines and Information Brochure thoroughly before applying online.
- After submitting the online application successfully, a confirmation sheet/application submission form, bearing the full application summary with the photo & signature of the candidate, will be generated by the system. Application is not complete until the confirmation sheet/application submission form is generated.
- Candidates have to download and print the confirmation sheet/application submission form and should preserve the same carefully.
- Photograph and signature must be maintained in proper pixel and aspect ratio.
- Candidates are advised to ensure the correctness of their complete mailing address, pin code, e-mail address and mobile number. Please note, that the University will not be responsible if candidates could not be reached due to incomplete or incorrect address, Email Id, or mobile number.
- Select the admission test-centres in order of your preference.
- Final decision regarding allotment of the Entrance Test/Examination-Centre for AUAT-2024 will be taken by the authority.
- Request for change of Entrance Test/Examination-centre at any stage will not be entertained.

19.2. Marks/ Marksheet Upload

- Candidates have to upload the required Marks/Marksheets/Documents during online application, but the candidates who are appearing in the qualifying examination they have to upload required Marks/Marksheets/Documents as per the notification/application guidelines given in the Aliah University website (www.aliah.ac.in).

19.3. Admit Card

- Candidates have to download and print the admit card within the stipulated time by logging in into admission portal by using his/her User ID and Password.
- Entrance Test/Examination venue and schedule will be mentioned in the admit card.
- No hardcopy admit-card will be sent to the candidates.
- The admit-card will bear the name, photograph, signature, address and category of the candidate along with name and address of the Test/Examination-centre.
- The candidates are advised to carefully examine the admit card. In case of any discrepancy, the candidate should inform the AUAT office immediately.

19. Admission Procedure

19.4. Aliah University Admission Test (AUAT-2024)

- Candidates have to appear for the Aliah University Admission Test (AUAT-2024) as per the Date, Time & Venue mentioned in the admit card.
- Appearing in the examination does not guarantee for admission.
- Please follow the university website (www.aliah.ac.in) regularly for updated information.

19.5. Provisional Merit List

- Provisional Merit List/ Result will be published and candidates have to download and print the Rank Card by logging in into admission portal by using his/her User Id and Password.
- A list of successful candidates of different programmes will be displayed separately on the Aliah University website (www.aliah.ac.in).
- Merit list will be prepared solely based on admission test score (except for B.Ed. programme).
- Separate list of successful candidates will also be prepared for the physically challenged (PC) candidates.

19.6. Counselling

- Candidates having valid rank are only eligible for counselling.
- Counselling will be held for programme codes U13 (B.Sc. Honours in Mathematics/ Statistics), U14 (B.Sc. Honours in Botany/ Microbiology/ Zoology) and U21 (B.Tech/BCA) to select the specific programme/subject. A general merit list will be published for each programme codes individually and next to get allotment, candidates have to be present physically for offline counselling on the schedule date, time and venue to select the specific programme/course.
- Counselling will be held for programme codes U08 (B.A. Honours in Islamic Theology) and P08 (M.A. in Islamic Theology) to select the study centre. A general merit list will be published for B.A. Honours and M.A. in Islamic Theology Programmes and next to get allotment, candidates have to be present physically for offline counselling on the schedule date, time and venue to select the study centre.
- The choice submitted by the candidates during counselling will be processed and a seat will be allotted based on merit/rank.
- Taking part in counselling process does not guarantee the admission.
- In case any candidate fails to attend the counselling process being present physically, his/her candidature will be cancelled.
- Any decision taken by the conducting authority in regard to any issue related to counselling will be deemed as final.
- The list of eligible candidates to attend the offline counselling schedule, procedure, venue and other relevant details will be made available on Aliah University website(www.aliah.ac.in).

19. Admission Procedure

19.7. Provisional Allotment List

- Provisional Allotment list will be published at the scheduled date. Candidates have to regularly follow Aliah University website (www.aliah.ac.in).
- Candidates who will be enlisted in the provisional allotment list only can pay the admission fees online.
- The allotment offered at the counselling is only a provisional allotment.
- All the available seats will be considered for allotment.

19.8. Online Payment For Admission

- Candidates will be informed about the schedule of online payment for admission along with the provisional allotment list. Within that scheduled date & time candidates will have to pay the admission fee through online mode only.
- Candidates are advised to check once again the eligibility criteria for the applied programme before making payment for the admission. If any candidate fails to satisfy the eligibility criteria, his/her admission will be cancelled and there will be no refund of fees.
- After paying the fees online candidates must have to take a printout of the payment receipt.
- In any case, if the candidate fails to pay the admission fee, his/her candidature will be cancelled.
- At any stage of admission procedure if any discrepancy is found, the admission of the candidate will be cancelled and there will be no refund of fees.

19.9. Documents Verification & Final Admission

- After paying the admission fee, candidates have to be present physically at the specified venue on the scheduled date and time, with photocopy of all the required documents, along with their originals for verification. Admission fee-payment-receipt also has to be submitted to complete the admission process.
- All admission will be provisional. Admission through AUAT-2024 will stand cancelled at any stage of the admission process if the candidate fails to satisfy the eligibility criteria.
- All admissions are subject to verification of particulars from the original admit card, original mark sheet/grade card and other documents of the candidates.
- During document-verification, if the personal data submitted by the candidate at the time of online registration/application is found to be false, his/her admission is liable to be cancelled.

AT ANY STAGE OF THE ADMISSION PROCESS IF ANY DISCREPANCY IS FOUND, AND IF THE CANDIDATE FAILS TO SATISFY THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA, THE ADMISSION OF THE CANDIDATE WILL BE CANCELLED AND THERE WILL BE NO REFUND OF ANY FEES.

10. Migration certificate for Other-State candidates (UG programmes) and all PG candidates, if he/she has previously studied in any another University.
11. Transfer certificate or college leaving certificate issued by the college. No other certificate in lieu of this will be accepted.
12. Character certificate to be obtained on the college letter head/pad, no other certificate in lieu of this will be accepted.
13. Residential proof (Voter Card/Aadhaar Card).
14. Domicile certificate in prescribed format (see **ANNEXURE-I**) for U21 and U22 programmes.
15. Physical Fitness certificate (only for B.Sc. in Nursing programme): Candidates have to submit a Physical Fitness Certificate from a registered medical practitioner in the prescribed format (see **ANNEXURE-II**). Candidates will be allowed to take admission into B.Sc. Nursing programme only if they are found physically fit to pursue the programme at Aliah University.

Criteria for Residential/Domicile of West Bengal

Only those candidates will be treated as domicile of West Bengal who are either,

A) residing in West Bengal continuously for at least 10 (ten) years as of 31.12.2023.

OR

B) whose parent(s) is/are a permanent resident(s) of West Bengal having permanent address within the State of West Bengal. In the case of (A) above, a certificate is to be obtained as per proforma 'a1' (**Appendix – 1**) or proforma 'a2' (**Appendix – 2**). In case of (B) above, a certificate is to be obtained in proforma 'b' (**Appendix – 3**), or the candidate must produce in original any two of Voter ID card/ Aadhaar card/ Passport/ Ration card belonging to his/her parents. The said documents must justify that the residential address of the parent(s) is/are in West Bengal.

Competent authority to issue domicile certificate

- a) Proforma 'a1' or 'b' must be signed and certified by any of the following competent authorities from the Central Government or State Government having local jurisdiction over the place of the permanent residence of the concerned candidate or his/her parent(s) viz.
 - i. District Magistrate, Additional District Magistrate, Deputy Magistrate, Deputy Collector, Sub – Divisional Officer, Block Development Officer.
 - ii. Superintendent of Police, Additional Superintendent of Police, Sub Divisional Police Officer, Deputy Superintendent of Police,
 - iii. Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner, Assistant Commissioner of Police Commissionerate.
 - iv. Judicial Magistrate of any rank or position in the concerned district, Metropolitan locality, or Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta or Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
 - v. Corporation Area - Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, Assistant Commissioner.
 - vi. Assistant Secretary or above in the Secretariat to the Government of West Bengal (including GTA) or Central Government.
 - vii. Deputy Director or above in the Directorate to the Government of West Bengal or Central Government.
 - viii. Collector of Kolkata (Stamp and Revenue) located at 11, N.S. Road, Kolkata-700001 for the inhabitants under the jurisdiction of Kolkata Police Area.
- b) Officials issuing domicile certificates MUST provide their full name, designation, place of posting with address, and landline/mobile number. He/she should also provide his/her identity card number if available.
- c) Domicile certificates issued by any elected people's representative such as Municipal Commissioner, Councillor of Municipal Corporation/ Municipality, Member of a three-tier Panchayat system or GTA, MLA or MP are unacceptable.
- d) Proforma 'a2' must be signed and certified by the Head of the Institution from which the candidate has passed or will appear in the 10+2 examination. Such a certificate must be issued after verifying the candidate's school education record.

20. Reservation of Seats

20.1. Physically Challenged (PC) Candidates /Person with Disability (PwD)

4 % seats are reserved for candidates belonging to the PC/PwD category, who are otherwise fit to pursue any programme. For any category of disability (viz., orthopaedic, visual, speech, and/or hearing), benefit would be given to those candidates who have atleast 40 % permanent physical impairment in relation to a body part/system/extremity/extremities/ whole body, etc.

The candidates in this category will be required to submit a certificate of impairment from the competent authority.

NB: After the last counselling if any reserved seat/seats remain vacant, the University will fill up the vacant seat/seats from GEN category strictly from the merit list, or vice versa.

20.2. For Nursing programme: for disabled candidates

5% Disability reservation to be considered with a disability of locomotor to the tune of 40% to 50% of the lower extremity and other eligibility criteria with regard to age and qualification will be same as prescribed for nursing programme.

Further, it has also been resolved by INC that a committee to be framed considering of medical officers authorized by medical board of the State Government and a Nursing Expert in the panel which may decide whether the candidates have the disability of locomotor of 40% to 50%.

20.3. General

The category of a candidate other than PC/PwD and is hereby termed as General category.

NB: After the last counselling if any reserved seat/seats remain vacant, the University will fill up the vacant seats from PC category strictly from the merit list, or vice versa.

20.4. Students from Jammu, Kashmir and Ladakh

Students from Jammu, Kashmir and Ladakh may take admission in Aliah University under Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS) in 2024-25, 10 supernumerary seats are available in B.Tech. Programmes with a limit of two seats per branch and 10% supernumerary seats are available in B.Sc. Nursing programme.

20.5. Students from WBJEE (For B.Tech. only)

20% seats (12 seats) in each of B. Tech. Programmes are reserved for candidates from WBJEE-2024 merit list

20.6. Students from JELET (for lateral entry to the 2nd year of B. Tech. Programmes only)

2 seats in each of B. Tech. Programmes are reserved for candidates with valid JELET rank.

N.B.: 80 % of 48 no. of seats (38 seats) are reserved for domicile of West Bengal (Applicable for programme codes U21 & U22). If reserved seats remains vacant, it will be filled up by general candidates.

20. Reservation of Seats

20.7. For all the Post Graduate programmes (except M.A. in Education, MJMC), 80% seats will be reserved for internal candidates.

20.8. For M.A. in Journalism and Mass Communication, the division of seats are 50% for BA in JMC/Media Science/Film Studies, 25% for Science/Engineering and 25% for Humanities/Social Sciences.

20.9. The seats reserved for internal candidates may be filled from the list of external candidates if the list of internal candidates exhaust, and vice-versa.

21. Merit Score Calculation

Merit calculation will be solely on Aliah University Admission Test - 2024 score (except B.Ed. programme). For B.Ed. programme, final merit score will be calculated based on Aliah University Admission Test - 2024 score, and academic score.

22. Entrance Test Centres

Probable Aliah University Admission Test - 2024 Venues

1. Aliah University Admission Test (AUAT)-2024 for B.Sc. in Nursing and B.Ed. programme will be conducted only at Kolkata Centre.
 2. Aliah University Admission Test (AUAT)-2024 for other UG programmes will be conducted only at a few strategically located towns in West Bengal. Candidates have to choose any two centres as first and second choice.
 3. Aliah University Admission Test (AUAT)-2024 for all PG programmes will be conducted only at Kolkata Centre.
- Final decision regarding allotment of the Entrance Test/Examination-Centre for AUAT-2024 will be taken by the competent authority.
 - Request for change of Entrance Test/Examination-centre at any stage will not be entertained.
