The following pledge is to be read aloud by all students in presence of faculty members.

- I shall never participate in, encourage, or tolerate ragging in any form—physical, verbal, psychological, online, or indirect.

- I shall have the courage to speak up and report any incident of ragging, knowing that silence can also cause harm.
- I shall help create a campus where kindness is stronger than fear, friendship is stronger than bullying, and humanity is our greatest identity.

With this pledge, I dedicate myself to making Aliah University a safe, inclusive, and ragging-free campus."
