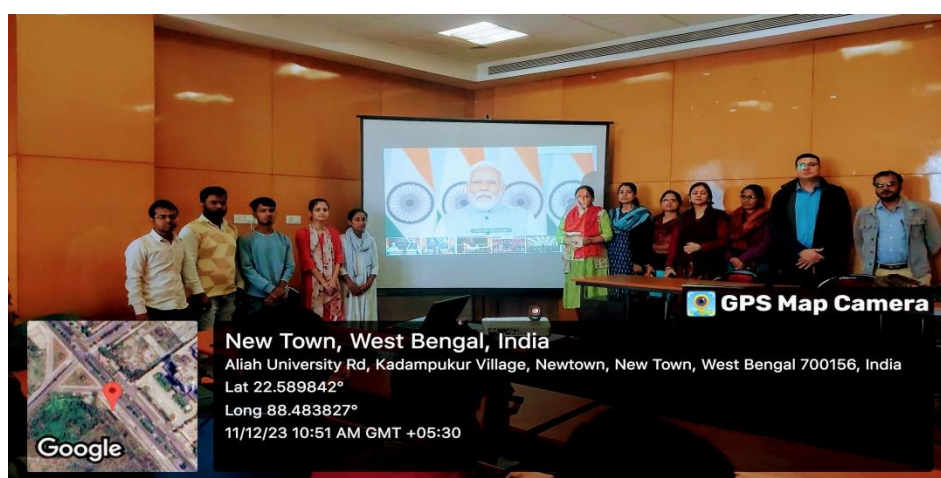
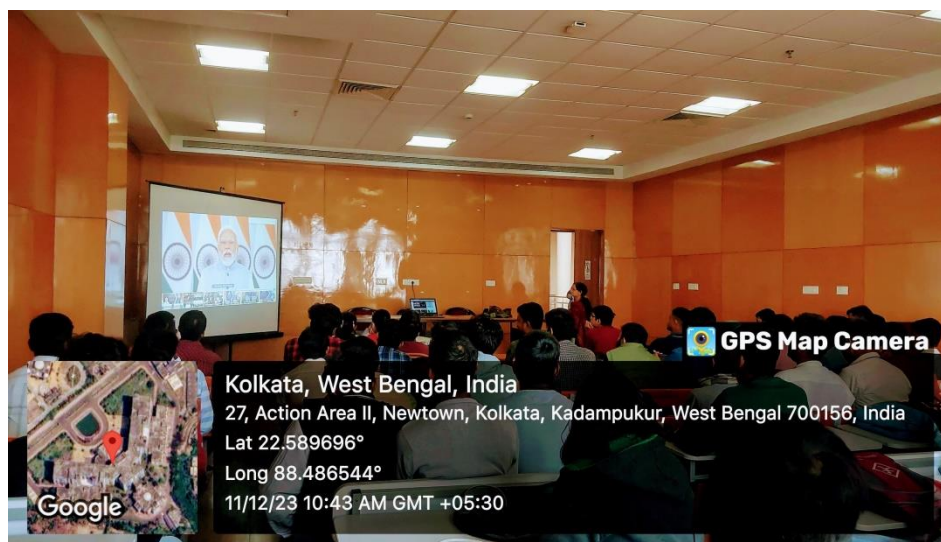
3. Report on Inaugural Address by Hon'ble Prime Minister at Viksit Bharat@2047 Utsav
