


# REPORT ON ACTIVITIES OF INSTITUTION INNOVATION COUNCIL ALIAH UNIVERSITY, KOLKATA


# 2.2.1 Awareness Program on E-Resources of National Digital Library of India (NDLI)

## 2.2.3. Online Seminar on Gandhi and Women in Indian Freedom




# 2.2.4. Online Seminar on Your Library: A True Friend, Guide & Philosopher




# 2.2.6. Online Training on Exploring OPAC & E-Resources of Aliah Library System























