Aliah University Science and Technology Club (AUSTC) is established on 13th March 2019 as a result of the utmost effort of few founder members, and the Dean of faculty of science and technology, Aliah University and the Dean of Students Welfare, Aliah University. The major objectives set for the AUSTC are:

- To develop among the students the spirit and attitude of healthy competition for the individual and social cause and to help them imbibing habit of self- reliance, self-dependence and love for manual work.
- To make the students understand the values of time and to motivate them for proper utilization of their hours by generating multidimensional interest in their mind about the latest inventions and discoveries of science & technologies including life and contributions of great scientists.
- To develop student's interest in participation in the practical application of the knowledge related to different branches of science.
- To inculcate scientific attitude and provide opportunities for training in scientific method.
- To develop interest in scientific hobbies, group activities and sense of healthy competition.

The club came into official existence with the approval of the Hon'ble vice Chancellor, Aliah University on the basis of the Proposal submitted for the formation of such club enclosing details of the aims and objectives of the club and the list of its office bearers. Immediately after getting approval from the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor the office bearers convened a meeting to finalize the Official LOGO of the club which was subsequently approved by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor. Thereafter a letter is issued vide Memo No. **AU/REG/0299/19.....** dated **..13/03/2019...** by the Registrar of

the University regarding this. On completion of all official formalities a space is allocated for day to day activities of the club. The club is inaugurated officially on 21 November 2019. The inaugural session was presided by Dr. Md. Abdul Khan, Chairman AUSTC with the graceful presence of Prof. Dr Amzed Hussain, Registrar (acting) and Dean of Students Welfare Aliah University, Prof. Dr. Md. Mehedi Kalam, Dean of the Faculty of Sc. & Technology, Aliah University, Dr Manuar Hossain, Controller of Examinations, Aliah University, all members of AUSTC, Faculty members and students of Aliah University. The inaugural program followed by a one day seminar on IoT and Entrepreneurship trends in Technical field. In the technical session PPT lecture were delivered by Dr D Atta, Department of Technical Education and Training, Govt. Of West Bengal and Two executives from the leading multinational companies were invited to give career guidance to our students through interactive session. A very exciting and highly motivating speech was delivered by Mr Zakir Hossain, Training and Placement Officer, Aliah University. Nearly one hundred students and faculty members were present in the program.

On that occasion, we launched the official Logo of the club and deliberated on the proposed activities and objective of the club in front of the students and faculty members present. We propose for conducting Hackathon and Tech fest on 2020. As the coronavirus pandemic marches around the world, leading to unprecedented measures to stop the virus's spread, the number of seminars and workshops and technical festivals and cultural festivals were being cancelled.

On the occasion of the inaugural session some banners and slogans of the club were displayed. Some of the pictures taken on the occasion are enclosed along with the letter of official approval of the club.

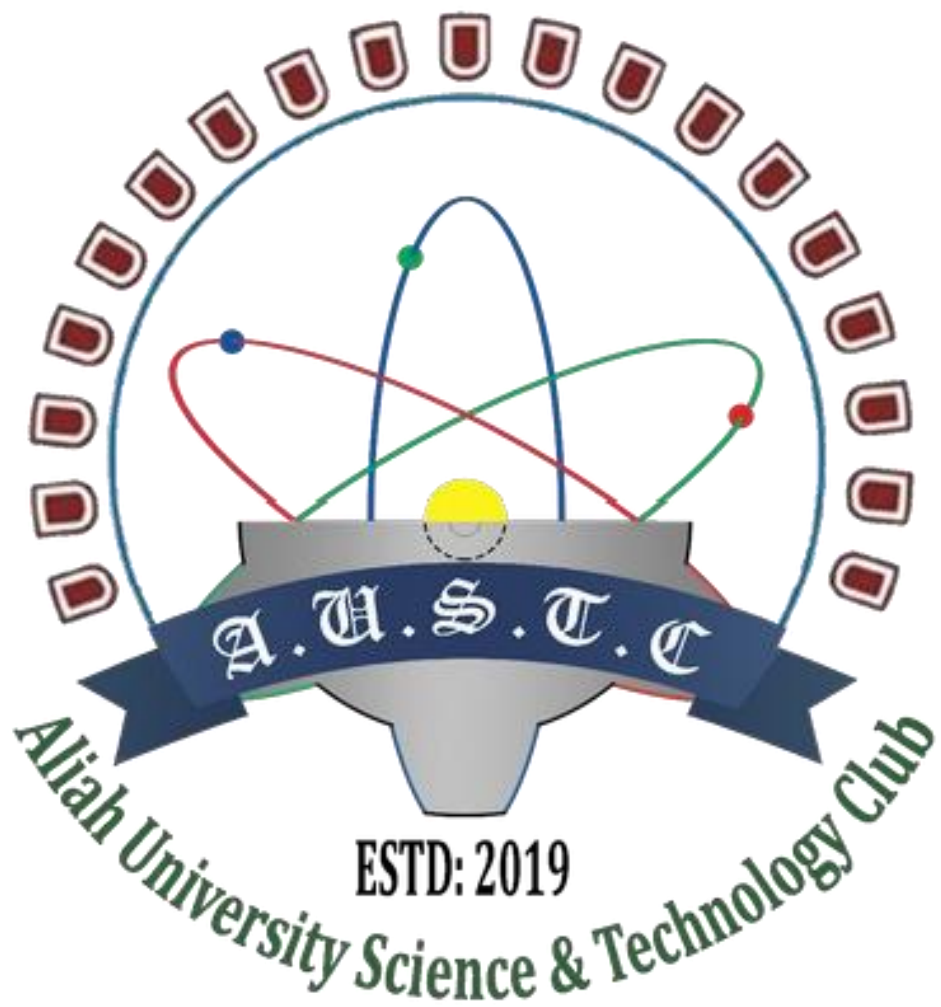
We , the students of Aliah University , with the help of our University administration have created Aliah University Science & Technology Club (AUSTC).




