Manuscript Submission Guidelines

(Style Sheet)

1. All submissions should be in MS-Word, 1.5 spaced throughout (not only the text but also displayed quotations, notes, references and any other matter) on single-sided numbered page.

A cover page must be provided mentioning the title of the article and the author's name, professional affiliation, addresses (both postal and e-mail) and phone numbers.

2. All submissions must include an **Abstract** (between 150-200 words) and five (05) **keywords** at the beginning of the articles. Must enclosed plagiarism checking certificate with 10 percent and below with self-declaration certificate also. This journal will be applied to enlist in UGC-CARE list.

3. Referencing Style: References should be provided as endnotes. A **Reference List** should provide a complete list of all references cited in the article. Do not distinguish between primary and secondary references; they must all be included in one alphabetized list. Referencing format should be followed latest APA 7th edition.

The examples provided below illustrate the style to be followed:
