

Guidelines for allotment and evaluation of Project/Review work

1. A student has to carry out a project/review work in a topic given by his/her supervisor in the BSc 6th semester.
2. The project/review will carry a total 25 Marks (equivalent to 2 Credits).
3. The supervisors will be assigned to the students by lottery amongst all the faculties present for that semester.
4. Students must submit a detailed report of the work/review within a stipulated time.
5. During examination the students must undertake a viva voce through presentation before an evaluation team (which may include one expert from outside).
6. The final report will be evaluated based on the quality of the report and performance in viva voce. The distribution of marks will be as follows-
 - a. Report 10 marks
 - b. Presentation 10 marks
 - c. Discussion 5 marks
7. In case there is any change in total number of marks/ credits for the end semester examination, the marks would be proportionally adjusted as per the scheme above.
