CANDIDATE APPEARING THE 10+2 EXAMINATION IN 2018, SHOULD UPLOAD THEIR FINAL (10+2) MARKS AFTER PUBLICATION OF THE 10+2 RESULT (Marks Uploading Date will be Notified in Aliah University Website)

** Candidates appearing in the (10+2) examination are also eligible to appear in AUAT-2018. However, their admission will be cancelled if they fail to secure the minimum prescribed marks/grade in final examination or fail to produce final Mark Sheet/Grade Card at the time of Admission as mentioned.

*** Candidates appearing in final year examination are also eligible to appear in AUAT-2018. However, their admission will be cancelled if they fail to secure the minimum prescribed marks/grade in final examination or fail to produce final Mark Sheet/Grade Card at the time of Admission.

Successful Candidates applied for E 01 programme, will be admitted directly to the second year of 4-year B Tech Programmes.

Successful Candidates applied for D12programmes, will be allotted to B.A. in Theology (Honours) according to the merit list, and allotted to B.A. in Theology (General) if all honours seats are filled up.

SPONSORRED CANDIDATES: Candidates working in different govt. /private organization may apply for **E 01, C10, C13 and C20** programmes. There is no age limit for such candidates. However, they have to apply through proper channel.

Though the upper age limit is mentioned above, however all the Candidates of **UG Courses** who have passed Higher Secondary (10+2) examination before 2016 is not eligible to appear in AUAT-2018.

All PG Courses: Candidates who have acquired Graduation degree before 2017 (except MJMC and LLM) is not eligible to appear in AUAT-2018 though the upper age limit is mentioned above.

3. PATTERN OF AUAT-2018

All questions of AUAT- 2018 (UG and PG) will be 80% from the relevant subject and 20% on General knowledge and Islamic Culture. The paper of AUAT-2018 examination is of 1hour duration (50 marks in total) for UG and 1 ½ hours duration (100 marks in total) for PG programmes

- all B. Tech.programmes will comprise of Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics.
- all UG programmes (except B. Tech.) will comprise of relevant subjects only.
- Nursing programme will comprise of Biology, Chemistry, and Physics.
- Integrated BBA-MBA programme will be on basic Mathematics, verbal and non-verbal reasoning, Commercial Arithmetic and elementary knowledge in concerned area.
- all 2-years Masters programmes (including M. Tech programmes) except MJMC, will be on the concerned subject.
- MJMC will be on English (concept of Language and Literature), Fundamentals of Journalism & Mass Communication having its role as fourth pillar of Indian Democracy, Sports and Cinema..
- 3-year MCA programme will comprise of Reasoning, Quantitative Aptitude, Data Interpretation, Problem Solving Questions, Discrete Quantitative Analysis and Basic Mathematics.
- LATERAL ENTRY to B. Tech programme will be comprised of Engg. Mathematics, Basic Computer Science, Strength of Material, Engg. Mechanics Environmental Engg. & Basic Electrical Technology.

N.B. Questions in all papers will be of objective type in multiple choice questions (MCQ) format, which are to be answered on a specially designed machine-gradable sheet (ORS-Optical Response Sheet) using Black/Blue ball point pen only.

For the language programmes (3-year B.A. and 2-year M.A. in English, Bengali and Arabic) it may have 20% marks of descriptive questions also. The qualifying marks for descriptive part are 50%in English and Bengali).

- **Final merit list for UG & B.Ed. courses will be prepared on the basis of academic score and AUAT-2018 score.**
- **For PG courses merit list will be prepared on the basis of AUAT-2018 score.**

4. SYLLABI

- a) For all **4-year B.Tech and UG Programmes** (except MBA, Arabic, Urdu, Islamic Theology and B.Ed): Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, English, Geography as per syllabi of classes XI and XII of West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education (WBCHSE) and Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE).
- b) For **5-year Integrated in MBA**: Concept of English in Language and literature, Basic and Business Mathematics, Elements of Statistics and Elementary Knowledge on concerned area.
- c) For all **2-year Masters Programmes** (except MJMC and M. Tech): As per syllabus of 3-year Bachelor Degree Courses of recognized Indian Universities in Honours/Major disciplines.
- d) For **2-year MJMC**: English: Concept of Language and Literature; Journalism and Mass Communication: Basic Concept and Historical Development – Role as the fourth pillar of Indian Democracy; Political and Social Science: Contemporary Issues on National and International Perspectives; Sports and Cinema.
- e) For **LLM Programme**: According to the LLB programme of recognized Indian Universities.
- f) For **3-year Honours in Arabic and Urdu**: As per the Arabic and Urdu syllabus of H.S. or equivalent examination.
- g) For **3-year B.A. in Theology (Honours and General)**: As per Syllabus of Fazil according of West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education.
- h) For **3-year MCA**: As per the JECA examination, West Bengal.
- i) For **Lateral Entry to B. Tech Programmes**: As per the Syllabi of JELET, West Bengal.
- j) For **BSc (Nursing)**: As per the Syllabi of JENPARH, West Bengal.
- k) For **2-years M. Tech**: As per the syllabus of GATE.

5. RESERVATION OF SEATS

5.1 Physically Challenged (PC) Candidates

For candidates belonging to the PC category, who are otherwise fit to pursue the course and qualify in AUAT-2018 with relaxed norms relevant to this category, 3% seats are reserved as specified by the Government of India. For any category of disability (viz., orthopedic, visual, speech, and/or hearing), benefit would be given to those candidates who have at least 40% permanent physical impairment in relation to a body part/system/extremity/extremities/ whole body, etc. The candidates in this category will be required to submit a certificate of impairment from the competent authority.

NB: The category of a candidate other than PC is hereby termed as GEN category.

5.2 Students from Jammu & Kashmir

Students from Jammu & Kashmir may take admission in Aliah University under Prime Minister's Special Scholarship Scheme (PMSSS) J&K 2018-19. In our University total 10 supernumerary seats are available in B.Tech. courses with a limit of two seats per branch for them.

5.3 Students from Foreign Countries

Students from foreign countries with requisite qualifications may appear in AUAT 2018 for admission.

5.4 Students from WBJEE (for B Tech only)

10% of the seats in 4-year B. Tech. Programmes, are reserved for the students who will be successful in WBJEE-2018 examinations. These candidates are exempted from appearing AUAT-2018.

5.5 Scholarship

It is informed to all admitted candidates through AUAT-2018 of all courses that Aliah University has no scholarship of its own. However eligible students may apply for scholarship/ fellowship etc. as and when applications are invited by the Government or any other sponsoring agency. The university will only verify and help in submitting the documents of the students for scholarship.

NB: After the last counselling if any reserved seat/seats remain vacant, the University has every right to fill up the vacant seats from GEN category strictly from the AUAT 2018 merit list.

6. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION

- (a) Candidates applying for AUAT-2018 should have passed / expected to pass the qualifying examination listed in Section 6.1
- (b) Candidates should meet the age requirements as mentioned in the brochure.

6.1 Qualifying Examination for UG programmes.

- a) The final examination of the 10+2 system, conducted by any recognized Central/State Board, such as West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Examination (WBCHSE), West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education (WBBME), Central Board of Secondary Education (New Delhi) (CBSE), Council for Indian School Certificate Examination (ISC), etc.
- b) Intermediate or two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by a recognized Board/University.
- c) Final Examination of the two-year course of the Joint Services Wing of the National Defense Academy.
- d) General Certificate of Education (GEC) Examination (London/Cambridge/Sri Lanka) at the Advanced (A) level.
- e) High School Certificate Examination of the Cambridge University.
- f) Any Public School/Board/University Examination in India or in any foreign country recognized by the Association of Indian Universities as equivalent to the 10+2 system.
- g) Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) with a minimum of five subjects or H.S. Examination Conducted by W.B. Council of Rabindra Open Schooling.

6.2 Important Notes

1. All admissions will be provisional for those candidates who are appearing in the qualifying examination in the year 2018. Admission through AUAT-2018 will stand cancelled if the proof of having passed the Qualifying Examination, as per the eligibility criteria is not submitted on the date of Admission to Aliah University.
2. All admissions are subject to verification of facts from the original certificates/documentations of the candidates. If an applicant is found ineligible at a later date even after admission to a programme, his/her admission will be cancelled. The decision of the authority regarding the eligibility of any applicant shall be final.

6.3 Physical Fitness

All qualified candidates may be required to submit a Physical Fitness Certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner in the prescribed format that will be made available to them at an appropriate time. They will be admitted only if they are physically fit for pursuing a course of study at Aliah University.

8. ADMIT CARD

Candidates have to download and print their admit cards from the University website by logging in by putting their application form number (Application id) and date of birth (password) before one week of concerned examination. **Candidates are requested to follow university website (admission section) for regular updates.**

No admit card will be sent to the respective candidates.

The Admit Card will bear the Name, Photograph, Signature, Address, and Category of the candidate along with Name and Address of the Examination Centre allocated. The candidate should carefully examine the Admit Card received by him/her for all the entries made therein. In case of any discrepancy, the candidate should inform the AUAT office immediately.

9. SELECTION PROCESS

9.1 Ranking, E-counselling and Admission

A list of Successful candidates appearing different programmes of AUAT-2018 will be displayed separately on the University website: www.aliah.ac.in. Separate list of successful candidates will also be prepared for the Physically Challenged (PC) candidates. Admission to different programmes will be made through **online counselling** according to the rank in the merit list. A rank card, containing all relevant information regarding counselling, will be provided to all successful candidates at the time of publication of result of AUAT-2018.

To participate in the online counselling, the successful candidates will have to register themselves in **University counselling portal** (to be announced at the time of publication of the result) by paying a **registration fee** through online mode (credit/debit card/net banking). A registered candidate will be offered to put their preference of subjects (if any) accordingly. The online system will allot the candidates to different programmes according to their rank and preferences. After allotment, the candidates will be directed to complete the original documents verification and complete the admission process within the time period (to be specified in the counselling portal).

If a candidate fails to complete the admission process within the stipulated time period, then the seats will be offered for the candidates next in rank.

The Counselling Registration fee will be adjusted with the Admission fees / 1st semester Tuition fees of the course in which the candidate is taking admission. But it is **non-refundable for the candidates whose name is being shortlisted but remain absent at the admission within the stipulated time period OR his/her candidature is rejected in verification of documents.** However, the candidates who will not be called for admission even after registration due to unavailability of seats, the entire registration fee will be refunded after deducting the bank transfer charges.

The allotment offered at the online counselling is only a provisional allotment; the candidature of a candidate will be automatically cancelled, if he/she does not satisfy the eligibility criteria.

Note: There will be a common merit list for all B. Tech programmes and there will be Separate merit lists for rest of the programmes.

IF A SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATE FAILS TO REGISTER IN THE COUNSELLING PORTAL WITHIN STIPULATED TIME, UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES CANDIDATE WILL BE ALLOWED TO TAKE PART IN THE ADMISSION PROCESS.

Successful candidates, who has appeared their qualifying examination in 2018, and whose final result have been published by the last date of e-counselling-registration, but could not secure marks of minimum eligibility, will not be allowed to register in the counselling portal.

9.2 Verification of Identity

The main purpose of asking the qualified candidates to appear in person is to verify their identity and original documents to complete the admission process. Hence the candidates must bring their Admit Cards and various other documents for verification of their identity of Age, Marks-sheet of Qualifying Examination, Domicile Certificate, and Category (for PC), all in original with one attested photocopies of each and **requisite admission fees** as verified in the University website www.aliah.ac.in/ Counselling portal. On failing to establish the authenticity of any of the above documents, the candidate will not be considered for admission.

10. PERFORMANCE IN AUAT-2018

The machine gradable Optical Response Sheets (ORS) are graded and scrutinized with extreme care. There is no provision for re-totalling. No photocopies of the Machine Gradable Sheets will be made available.
